Detalles del viaje: 12 días

Ida

● **Día 1** · UK - night on board

· Arrival at UK departure airport ready to check-in for overnight flight to Hanoi.

● **Día 2** · Hanoi

· Arrival in Vietnam's capital where a guide awaits. Transfer to the hotel. Take some time to rest in the hotel and depending on the arrival time of the flight, start to explore the wonderful city of Hanoi. Overnight stay.

● **Día 3** · Hanoi

· Breakfast at the hotel. Start with a visit to Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum, House on Stilts and the One Pillar Pagoda. Visit the Temple of Literature, its gardens and architecture offer a glimpse into Vietnam's past. In the afternoon, take a cyclo ride around the Old Quarter streets which were named after the specific goods once offered for sale at these places. Stop at Kiem Lake and visit Ngoc Son Temple, followed, by a Water Puppet show – a northern Vietnamese art form depicting scenes from rural life and national history. Overnight stay at hotel in Hanoi.

● **Día 4** · Hanoi - Ninh Binh - Hoa Lu - Tam Coc - Bich Dong

· After breakfast, you will take 2 hour drive to Ninh Binh Province. Our first visit is to Hoa Lu- Vietnam's former capital and the remains of Dinh & Le Kingdoms' Temples. After your lunch at a local restaurant, get on a small rowing boats to travel along the canals amid local villages, green fields. Enjoy the beauty of Tam Coc. Go through the caves and row back to the boat quay. Continue by bike to Bich Dong. Climb up to Ngu Nhac Son (Buddha's Palm Mountain), be charmed by the marvelous scenery offered by the mountains, rivers and pagodas. Overnight stay in Ninh Binh.

● **Día 5** · Ninh Binh - Halong Bay

· After breakfast, depart by road to Ha Long Bay, a World Heritage Area of outstanding natural beauty. Travel through the rich farmlands of the Delta of Red river and the landscape of rice fields, water buffalo, the daily life of the Vietnamese village. Arrive in Halong and board a traditional Junkship; an ancient sailing ship design that is still used today. Lunch on board. The cruise passes by many rocks and islets. The cruise may stop for a while to visit the Sung Sot cave. Dinner is ready at the time the boat anchors off at a quiet designated overnight area. Overnight stay on board at Halong Bay.

● **Día 6** · Halong Bay - Hanoi - Ho Chi Minh City

· In the morning, your brunch will be served on board as you pass by and see the beauties of the bay before returning to the Wharf. The junk continues cruising toward Ha Long port. Ready for disembarking. Our driver will be there to pick you up toward Hanoi and to Noi Bai Airport for a flight to Ho Chi Minh city. On arrival, you will be met by our guide and check in your hotel for an overnight stay in Ho Chi Minh City.

● **Día 7** · Ho Chi Minh City & Cu Chi Tunnels

· Breakfast at the hotel. Visit the War Remnants Museum. Continue to Reunification Palace. The tour finishes with Notre Dame Cathedral and the bustling Ben Thanh Market. In the afternoon, visit the Cu Chi Tunnels an underground city with living areas, kitchens, storage, weapon shops, field hospitals and command centers. Overnight stay in Ho Chi Minh City.

● **Día 8** · Ho Chi Minh City - Mekong Delta - Ho Chi Minh City - Siem Reap

· Breakfast at the hotel. Depart for a drive to Ben Tre province crossing the beautiful Rach Mieu bridge. On arrival in Hung Vong Pier hop on a motor boat on Bre Tre River - one of the tributaries of Mekong river while sight-seeing lively activities along river as fishing, water transferring. The first stop is at a brick kiln then a visit to a coconut processing workshop. Stop at a village's riverside restaurant for lunch. After lunch, transfer on a rowing-boat which will head along beautiful stream toward the pier for a transfer back to Ho Chi Minh City for a flight to Siem Reap. Upon landing in Siem Reap, you're welcomed by our guide and will check in your hotel. Overnight stay in Siem Reap.

● **Día 9** · Angkor Wat - Angkor Thom - Preah Khan Temple

· Breakfast at the hotel. Today explore the largest and most significant temples in the Angkor Complex. Start from the west gate of Angkor Thom. See the south gate, Bayon Temple - unique for its 54 towers decorated with over 200 smiling faces. Discover Avolokitesvara Baphuon Temple. Visit the Royal Enclosure, Phimeanakas, the Elephant Terrace and the Terrace of the Leper King. Visit Preah Khan Temple. In the afternoon visit the beautiful Buddhist temple of Ta Prohm and the temple of Banteay Kdei. Lastly, visit the famous temple of Angkor Wat. Admire the sunset over the temple before returning for an overnight stay in Siem Reap.

● **Día 10** · Siem Reap - Tonle Sap Lake - Siem Reap

⋮ Breakfast at the hotel. Take a boat trip on Tonle Sap Lake to visit a floating village and discover the local daily life and fishing activities. Back in town visit the Old Market and take the rest of the day at your leisure. Overnight stay in Siem Reap.

● **Día 11** · Siem Reap - U.K

⋮ Breakfast at the hotel. Day at your leisure in Siem Reap before your scheduled airport transfer for your departure flight back to the U.K.
