● Día 1 · UK - Oslo

• Arrival at UK departure airport ready to board your flight to Oslo. Arrive in Oslo. Explore the city for the rest of the day and discover the wonderful capital of Norway. Overnight stay.

● Día 2 · Oslo

• Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy a three-hour guided tour of the city, which includes views of the medieval fortress of Akershus, built in the 14th century, the Royal Palace, which is still home to the Norwegian monarch, and Vigeland Sculpture Park. Vigeland Sculpture park is the largest sculpture park in the world and contains 212 unique sculptures by the artist Gustav Vigeland. Remainder of the day spent at your leisure. Other enchanting attractions in Oslo to discover include the Munch Museum, which holds Munch's most mysterious and famous work, 'The Scream', and the Fram Polar Museum, where you can unearth the story of Norwegian polar exploration and see the strongest wooden ship ever built. Overnight stay.

● Día 3 · Oslo - Flåm - Balestrand

• Breakfast at the hotel. Depart on a scenic train journey to the quaint Norwegian village of Flåm, with a population of around only 350 people. On the way to Flåm, stop at the Myrdal mountain station to take in the scenery and enjoy the tranquility of the Norwegian mountains. In Flåm, enjoy some free time to discover this small village. Board the fast boat for Balestrand, a great base for further exploration of the majestic Norwegian landscape. Dinner at the hotel. Overnight stay.

● Día 4 · Balestrand

• Breakfast at the hotel. You can either spend the day at your leisure or embrace the opportunity of an optional excursion to Flærland.* Dinner at the hotel. Overnight stay. *A boat trip that will take you to Flærland, a village where the longest fjord in Norway meets the glaciers. As well as experiencing the amazing mountain views and lush landscape, you will get up close to the awe-inspiring Jostedal glacier, which is the largest glacier in continental Europe and is maintained by a constantly high rate of snowfall.

● Día 5 · Balestrand - Bergen


• Breakfast at the hotel. Take the morning to see some more of the sights in Balestrand, such as the picturesque St. Olaf Church, known locally as 'the English church', due to its surprising stylistic similarities. Later in the afternoon embark on the fast boat headed for Bergen. Bergen is a culturally diverse city that is nestled between crystal fjords and stretches of mountains. Take an evening stroll around the oldest quarter, Bryggen, meaning 'wharf', or discover the city's cuisine offerings as in 2016 it was awarded the UNESCO title of 'City of Gastronomy'. Overnight stay.

● Día 6 · Bergen

• Breakfast at the hotel. Embark on an informative and fascinating two-hour walking tour of this proud city and notice the multi-colored houses on the hill tops and the shoreline of the fjords, formed by several ice-ages which carved up the landscape into such intricate shapes. Immerse yourself in this ancient city which was part of the Hanseatic League in the middle-ages. The tour showcases the flamboyant fish-market and the narrow lanes of ancient Bryggen, which has become a symbol of the Norwegian national culture and has triumphantly gained a place on the UNESCO World Heritage list. Overnight stay.

● Día 7 · Bergen - UK

• Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy your last moments in Bergen at your leisure and if time allows, visit some other notable sights such as the museum of the famous composer, Edvard Grieg. Self-transfer to the airport for your scheduled flight back to the UK.
