Detalles del viaje: 18 días

Ida

● **Día 1** · UK - Hanoi

· Arrival at UK departure airport ready to check-in for overnight flight to Hanoi.

● **Día 2** · Hanoi

· Arrival in Vietnam's capital where a guide awaits. Transfer to the hotel. Take some time to rest in the hotel and depending on the arrival time of the flight, start to explore the wonderful city of Hanoi. Overnight stay.

● **Día 3** · Hanoi

· Breakfast at the hotel. Start with a visit to Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum, House on Stilts and the One Pillar Pagoda. Next up visit Tran Quoc Pagoda. Visit the Temple of Literature, its gardens and architecture offer a glimpse into Vietnam's past. Afterwards, take a cyclo ride around the Old Quarter streets. Stop at Hoan Kiem Lake to watch a Water Puppet show – a northern Vietnamese art form depicting scenes from rural life and national history. Overnight stay at hotel in Hanoi.

● **Día 4** · Hanoi- Ninh Binh - Hoa Lu - Tam Coc - Bich Dong-Hanoi

· Breakfast at the hotel. Depart for Ninh Binh Province. Visit Hoa Lu, Vietnam's ancient capital city and see the remains of Dinh and Le Kings' Temples. Lunch at a local restaurant followed by a rowing boat trip along the canals that surround the local villages and green fields. Enjoy the beauty of Tam Coc's three caves, also known as 'Halong Bay on land'. Row through the caves and back to the boat quay. Continue by bike to Bich Dong, a 2 kilometre ride away from Tam Coc, and declared by a King 'Vietnam's second most beautiful grotto'. Climb up the Ngu Nhac Son (Buddha's Palm Mountain), and be charmed by the marvelous scenery offered by the mountains, rivers and pagodas. Overnight stay in Hanoi.

● **Día 5** · Hanoi - Halong Bay

· Breakfast at hotel. Depart by road to Halong Bay, a World Heritage Area of outstanding beauty. Travel through the rich farmlands of the Delta of Red river and the landscape of rice fields, water buffalo and the daily life of the Vietnamese village. Arrive in Halong and board a traditional junk. Lunch on board. The cruise passes by many rocks and islets of fascinating shapes and it often stops for a while to visit the Sung Sot. Later, on board, move to a docking area for dinner and overnight stay.

● **Día 6** · Ha Long Bay - Hanoi - Ho Chi Minh City

· In the morning, enjoy a Taichi class on the sundeck. Mid morning, brunch will be served on board the cruise to further explore the beauties of the Bay before returning to the Wharf. The junk continues cruising towards Halong Port, ready for disembarking. Driver pick up to transfer you to Noi Bai Airport for a flight to Ho Chi Minh City. On arrival, meet your guide and check in to your hotel for an overnight stay.

● **Día 7** · Ho Chi Minh City & Cu Chi Tunnels

· Breakfast at the hotel. Visit the moving War Remnants Museum, which presents a parcial, yet riveting, view of the American War, as it is known in Vietnam. Continue to the Reunification Palace. The tour then proceeds to the Notre Dame Cathedral and the bustling Ben Thanh Market. In the afternoon, visit the Cu Chi Tunnels, located 70 kilometres northwest of Ho Chi Minh City, created in 1948 to assist the Viet Minh in combatting the French. This is an underground city with living areas, kitchens, storage, weapon shops, field hospitals and command centres. Two sections of the tunnel are open to visitors. Overnight stay in Ho Chi Minh City.

● **Día 8** · Ho Chi Minh City - Mekong Delta- Ho Chi Minh City - Siem Reap

· Breakfast at the hotel. Depart from hotel for a pleasant drive to Ben Tre Province, crossing the Rach Mieu bridge. On arrival in Hung Vuong Pier, hop on a motorized boat on the Ben Tre river, one of the tributaries of the Mekong river, while sight-seeing lively activities along the river such as fishing. Your first stop is at a brick kiln to see how to make traditional bricks by printing and baking. Continue to visit one of the many coconut processing workshops located along the canals and take a Tuk Tuk or a bicycle along the shady paths, pass by green rice fields and vegetable plains. Lunch at a local riverside restaurant. Take a rowing-boat along a beautiful water palm creek before meeting up with the motorized boat that will transfer you back to the pier. A car will pick you up and take you back to Ho Chi Minh City for a flight to Siem Reap. Upon landing, you are welcomed by our guide and checked in to your hotel. Overnight in Siem Reap.

● **Día 9** · Siem Reap - Angkor Wat - Angkor Thom - Preah Khan temple

· Breakfast at the hotel. Today explore the largest and most significant temples in the Angkor Complex. Start from the west gate of Angkor Thom, undiscovered by mass tourism; the ancient capital of Angkor Thom (12th century). See the south gate, Bayon Temple - unique for its 54 decorated towers. Discover Avolokitesvara Baphuon Temple, lying just to the north of Bayonm, a pyramidal representation of mythical Mont Meru. Visit the Royal Enclosure, Phimeanakas,

the Elephant Terrace and the Terrace of the Leper King. Visit Preah Khan Temple and the beautiful Buddhist temple of Ta Prohm, with its enormous fig trees, and also the temple of Bantey Kdei. Complete your visit at the famous temple of Angkor Wat, which has been a World Heritage site since 1992. Admire the sunset over the temple before returning for an overnight stay in Siem Reap.

● **Día 10** · Siem Reap - Tonle Sap Lake - Siem Reap

Breakfast at the hotel. Take a boat trip on Tonle Sap Lake to visit a floating village and discover the local daily life and fishing activities. Back in town visit the Old Market and take the rest of the day at your leisure to discover more delights of Siem Reap such as the War Museum or take a stroll around the shopping area, The Passage. Overnight stay in Siem Reap.

● **Día 11** · Siem Reap- Phuket

After breakfast at your hotel, spend any free time exploring Siem Reap, maybe visit one of the markets to pick up a handcrafted souvenir. Transfer to the airport for your flight to Phuket. Arrive in Phuket and transfer to your hotel, where you will experience beachside. Overnight stay.

● **Día 12** · Phuket

We suggest discovering this beautiful island. Phuket is located in the Andaman Sea, west of the Malaysian peninsula. The landscape combines lush forests and perfect beaches alongside beautiful places from which to contemplate spectacular sunsets. Overnight at your hotel.

● **Día 13** · Phuket

We recommend a quick boat trip to Phi Phi Island. This island was the scene of the movie The Beach. It is almost completely surrounded by cliffs submerged in the ocean, with some caves and a lake between two cliffs allowing water to enter the sea. Overnight at your hotel.

● **Día 14** · Phuket

You have the choice of exploring the island further or spending the day relaxing and getting the best out of the incomparable facilities of your hotel. Overnight stay.

● **Día 15** · Phuket

Continue enjoying your stay in Phuket and experience all the island has to offer. Fantastic nightlife and tranquil beaches provide a perfect antidote to our busy lives. Overnight at your hotel.

● **Día 16** · Phuket

Continue enjoying your stay in Phuket and experience all the island. We suggest unwinding by the beach in the afternoon.

● **Día 17** · Phuket - UK

If time allows spend the remainder of your day enjoying the nature that surrounds the island before transferring to the airport for an overnight flight back to the U.K.
