Detalles del viaje: 12 días



Ida

● Día 1 · UK - Mexico City

Depart from UK airport for your flight to Mexico. Arrival at the capital of Mexico and transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day free. Overnight stay.

● Día 2 · Mexico City

Breakfast at the hotel. Rest of the day free to start discovering the city. Overnight stay.

● Día 3 · Mexico City - Puebla - Oaxaca City

Breakfast and depart Mexico City at 8am to visit the beautifully decorated Temple of Santa Maria de Tonantzintla on the way to Puebla de los Angeles. After lunch, visit the Rosario Chapel, the Cathedral and the Plaza Mayor and the historic centre. Journey on to Oaxaca and transfer to the hotel for the night. Overnight stay.

● Día 4 · Oaxaca City

Breakfast at the hotel. Travel to Monte Alban, "White Mountain" the most majestic of Oaxaca's ancient Zapotec ruins with spectacular mountain top views. Then travel on to Mitla, a designated World Heritage Site, once an important Zapotec religious and ceremonial centre. Next visit Santa Maria del Tule and witness one of the world's most amazing trees, the Montezuma Cypress: The Tule Tree. Return to Oaxaca and discover the cathedral, the magnificent temple of Santo Domingo and the Gold Museum in this beautiful colonial city. Dinner before an overnight stay in Oaxaca.

● Día 5 · Oaxaca - San Cristobel de las Casas

Depart at early and enjoy breakfast and the changing landscape of the mountains en route to Tuxtla Gutierrez, the capital of Chiapas. On arrival transfer to the pier of the Grijalva River and travel by boat through the imposing Sumidero Canyon, a geological wonder, whose walls at times reach 1000 metres. Next transfer to San Cristobel de las Casas, passing through Chiapa de Corzo, a beautiful colonial town and transfer to the hotel for dinner. Overnight stay.

● Día 6 · San Cristobel de las Casas

Breakfast at the hotel. Depart and visit to the indigenous communities of San Juan Chamula and Zinacantan in the Los Altos de Chiapas region. Here the local people preserve their traditions, clothing and religious beliefs. The churches and homes are very picturesque and here you can take a walk through the beautiful streets to the Santo Domingo market, the Cathedral and the Jade museum, which holds a replica of King Pakala's tomb. Dinner and overnight in San Cristobel de las Casas.

● Día 7 · San Cristobel de las Casas - Palenque

Breakfast at the hotel. Depart for the thundering Cascades of Agua Azul. Cool off in the beautiful, naturally formed pools, surrounded by the abundant vegetation and typical fauna of the area. If time permits, visit the 35m jungle waterfall of Misol-Ha. Then continue on to Palenque for dinner and overnight stay.

● Día 8 · Palenque - Campeche

Breakfast at the hotel. Visit the archeological site of Palenque, located on the Tumbala mountains, looking out over the Usumacinta River flood plains. Here, find the Temple of Inscriptions which has contributed significantly to the study of Mayan civilization and see the Temple of the Foliated Cross, the largest and most significant pyramid within a complex of temples. Continue on to enjoy a panoramic view of the Gulf of Mexico on the way to the beautiful walled city of Campeche. Dinner and overnight stay in Campeche.

● Día 9 · Campeche - Merida

Breakfast at the hotel. Depart towards Uxmal, considered one of the most important archaeological sites of the Maya Culture. Here, visit the Pyramid of the Magician, el Cuadrangulo de las Monjas (the Nun's Quadrangle), the Governor's Palace and the Ball Court. After lunch continue on to Merida, "The White City" a town steeped in colonial history. Walk along the elegant "Paseo de Montejo" the city's main boulevard and see the "Monumento a la Patria", the main square with the Cathedral and the Government Palaces. Overnight in Merida.

● Día 10 · Merida - Cancún

Breakfast at the hotel. Depart for Chichen Itza, the most renowned city in Mexico, declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO and one of the "Seven New Wonders of the World". Visit the stepped pyramid called "El Castillo" or Temple of Kukulcan that dominates the centre of the archaeological site, the Temple of the Jaguars, the Observatory and the Plaza of a Thousand Columns. Afterwards take a swim in the majestic Sacred Cenote, once used to celebrate special events. After lunch , transfer to Cancún. Overnight stay.

● **Día 11** · Cancún - UK

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Cancún airport for your flight back to the UK. Night on board.

● **Día 12** · UK

Arrival at UK airport and end of your trip.
