Detalles del viaje: 12 días



Ida

● Día 1 · UK - Lima

· Arrival at UK departure airport ready to check in for your flight to Lima. Arrive in Lima and overnight at your hotel.

● Día 2 · Lima

· Breakfast at hotel. Day free to get to know the city. Overnight in Lima.

● Día 3 · Lima

· Breakfast at the hotel. We suggest taking the optional excursion for £25*. Overnight stay. *Visit the districts of Miraflores and San Isidro. Enjoy the panoramic view of Huaca Huallamarca and visit the Sant Domingo Convent. Walk through Plaza Mayor which is surrounded by Arzobispal palace, the metropolitan municipality and the cathedral. Stop to try a traditional Pisco Sour. Finally, visit the the Larco museum whose artefacts display more than 3000 years of Pre-Columbian history. Overnight stay.

● Día 4 · Lima - Puno

· Breakfast at the hotel. Take flight from Lima's airport to Juliaca. Arrival to Juliaca and transfer to Puno. Overnight stay in Puno.

● Día 5 · Puno

· Breakfast at the hotel. Excursion to Taquile and Uros island. Depart to Taquile island - Taquile has remnants of the past which date back to pre-Inca times. The islanders are famous for their beautiful clothing, their incredible knits, and textile industry. Next, visit the community of Huayllano, on the same island, where the locals show their traditional crafts and agriculture. Lunch . Visit the islands of Uros situated in the middle of the national reserve of Lake Titicaca. Transfer to hotel. Overnight stay.

● Día 6 · Puno - Cuzco

· Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Puno station to take a bus to Cuzco. Leave the station and start your journey on the bus to Puno and enjoy the marvelous landscapes of the South Valley of Cuzco. Visit Andahuaylas, the beautiful church of 17 th century, featuring an impressive organ decorated with angels and cherubs. Later on, visit the ruins of Racqui, also known as the 'Temple of the God Wiracocha and have lunch. Discover La Raya, the highest point on the highway between Cuzco and Puno for amazing views of the landscape. Arrival in Cuzco and transfer to hotel. Overnight stay.

● Día 7 · Cuzco

· Breakfast at the hotel. We suggest taking the optional excursion for £45*. Overnight stay. *Begin the day at Chinchero, a small picturesque town home to the important archeological Inca site, constructed in the final years of the decade of 1400, a beautiful and traditional church. Visit "Urpi" a famous textile centre, where the town people have conserved the Andean spinning techniques of knitting. Visit Ollantaytambo a fort which also served as a temple. On your way to Ollantaytambo, stop by Racchi viewpoint for a stunning picturesque photographic opportunity. Afterwards, continue towards the town adjacent to Ollantaytambo, "the only alive Inca town" which hasn't been inhabited since the 13 th century.

● Día 8 · Cuzco - Machu Picchu - Aguas Calientes

· Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the train station of Cuzco. Your adventure starts on board the Expedition train heading towards Aguas Calientes. Upon arrival, head to Machu Picchu for an unforgettable experience. Once in Machu Picchu, you will be able to cover each corner of this seventh wonder of the world, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Return to the town of Aguas Calientes for lunch. Rest of the day is free. Dinner and overnight stay.

● Día 9 · Aguas Calientes - Cuzco

· Breakfast at the hotel. At the indicated time, return to Cuzco. Arrival and transfer to hotel and day free to explore the area.

● Día 10 · Cuzco


· Breakfast at the hotel. You are free to spend the day at your leisure and explore the former Capital of the Incas.

● Día 11 · Cuzco - UK

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Cusco airport for your flight back to the UK. Night on board.

● **Día 12 · UK**

Arrival at UK airport and end of your trip.
