Detalles del viaje: 19 días

Ida

● **Día 1** · UK - Night on board

· Arrive at the departure airport ready to board your flight to Kilimanjaro Airport. Night on board.

● **Día 2** · Kilimanjaro - Arusha

· Arrival at Kilimanjaro airport and transfer to the hotel in Arusha, the most important city in the north of the country and "capital of the safari", being the main gateway and starting point for different wild expeditions. Overnight stay in Arusha.

● **Día 3** · Arusha - Tarangire

· Breakfast at the hotel. Leave for the Tarangire National Park named after the river that crosses through it. It hosts the highest concentration of wildlife outside the Serengeti ecosystem. In the afternoon, embark on an exciting safari to discover its wildlife and dream landscapes with lagoons and baobabs. Leave the park and travel along the shore of Lake Manyara to your hotel. Arrival, dinner and accommodation.

● **Día 4** · Tarangire - Lago Manyara - Karatu

· Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning take a safari walk through Lake Burunge, whose waters attract many species of beautiful birds. Enjoy a picnic lunch before you enter Lake Manyara National Park for an afternoon safari, to enjoy a great variety of African wildlife such as hippos, buffalo, elephants, giraffes and lions, who love to rest in the branches of acacia trees. Stop at a local market before you transfer to your camp in Karatu for dinner and overnight stay.

● **Día 5** · Karatu - Oldupai - Serengeti

· Breakfast in the camp. Today, leave for the Serengeti, first crossing the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Stop at the Oldupai Gorge, one of the most important sites for the investigation of the evolution of the human species due to its prehistoric paleontological and archaeological sites. Also, visit the Oldupai Gorge Museum and a fascinating outdoor excavation. Lunch at the camp. In the afternoon embark on a photographic safari in the park. Dinner and accommodation at the camp.

● **Día 6** · Serengeti

· Breakfast in the camp. Photographic safari at sunrise in the Serengeti National Park, the most famous in the world. The Maasai call it the "place of the infinite plains". More than three million mammals inhabit it, most of which migrate from Kenya in search of fresh grass. It is one of the best places to see cheetahs and gazelles and witness the mythical and impressive herds of wildebeest and zebras. Lunch at the camp. Return to the park to contemplate the beauty of the savannah with the magical light of the African sunset. Dinner and accommodation.

● **Día 7** · Serengeti - Ngorongoro - Karatu

· Breakfast in the camp. Leave for the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, a beautiful enclave of great plains, forests and lakes. Descend by a winding road to the base of the volcano to begin your safari. Extinct millions of years ago, it is a natural sanctuary for one of the densest animal populations in Africa where we can see black rhinos, zebras, hyenas, elephants and buffalo, among many others. Enjoy a picnic lunch beside a small lake inhabited by hippos. Transfer to your hotel for dinner and an overnight stay.

● **Día 8** · Karatu - Arusha

· Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning, visit a coffee farm. Arusha rises to 1300m above sea level and has a cool and humid climate, ideal for coffee plantations and for growing bananas. Enjoy a picnic lunch before you transfer to Kilimanjaro airport to board your flight to Zanzibar.
