Detalles del viaje: 8 días

Ida

● **Día 1** · UK - Bucharest

● Arrival at UK departure airport ready to check-in for the flight to Romania. Arrive in Bucharest, transfer to your hotel for dinner and overnight stay in the most luxurious city in the world.

● **Día 2** · Bucharest - Sibiu

● Breakfast at the hotel. Depart for Sibiu, one of the oldest cities in the country, stopping off on the way at Curtea de Argos to visit the monastery where the Kings of Romania are buried. On arrival in Sibiu take a walking tour through the city including a visit to the Plaza de Armas, the Evangelical Church and the Bridge of Liars. Dinner and overnight stay

● **Día 3** · Sibiu - Bistrita

● Breakfast at the hotel. Start the journey to Sighisoara, a medieval village, declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. En route enjoy a visit to the fortified church of Biertan. On arrival at Sighisoara take a walk around the city and visit the Clock Tower, the Church of the Hill and the Covered Stairs that lead to the church. Stop for lunch at the 'House of Dracula'. After lunch continue on to Targu Mures and visit the picturesque Palace of Culture. Continue on to Bisitra, the town where Jonathan Harker, the principal character in Bram Stoker's novel, spent the night before arriving at Dracula's Castle. Dinner at the hotel and overnight

● **Día 4** · Bistrita - Gura Humorului

● Breakfast at the hotel. Depart for Campulung Moldovenesc in the north east of Romania. After lunch continue on to visit the Moldovita Monastery which dates back to 1532. After returning to the hotel enjoy some free time followed by an organic dinner with traditional drinks in the hotel. Overnight stay.

● **Día 5** · Gura Humorului - Red Lake

● Breakfast at the hotel. Begin the day with a visit to the Voronet Monastery, known as the "Sistine Chapel of the East" and famous for its painting of the Last Judgement. Continue on through the villages of the region of Moldova and stop to visit the Agapia Monastery, a convent housing 300-400 orthodox nuns. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. Continue on the journey until reaching the Gorges of Bicaz and if time permits, stop for a pleasant walk to enjoy the beautiful landscape of the canyon. Arrive at Red Lake in time for dinner . Overnight at the hotel.

● **Día 6** · Red Lake - Brasov

● Breakfast at the hotel and then transfer to Brasov. En route stop to admire the beautiful fortified church in Prejmer, declared a World heritage Site by UNESCO. Continue on to Bran and enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. In the afternoon visit the famous medieval Bran Castle, known as the Castle of Dracula. Afterwards continue on to the city of Brasov and enjoy a tour of the historic centre. Discover the beautiful baroque buildings such as Catherine's Gate and the Black Church. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

● **Día 7** · Brasov - Bucharest

● Breakfast at the hotel. Depart for Sinaia, known as the "Pearl of the Carpathians". Visit the famous Peles Castle, the former summer residence of the royal family. Continue on to Bucharest and enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. In the afternoon take the panoramic tour of the capital, a city of contrasts between old and new with wide avenues and beautiful buildings such as the Romanian Athenaeum and the Palace of the Patriarchate. Visit the The Palace of the Parliament which is the second largest administrative building in the world after the Pentagon. Continue on with a walking tour through the old town and enjoy dinner at the famous Caru Cu Bere brasserie where they manage to retain the cosy atmosphere of the 19th century. Overnight at the hotel.

● **Día 8** · Bucharest - UK

● Breakfast at the hotel and transfer to the airport for the flight back to the UK. Arrival in UK and end of your trip.
