Detalles del viaje: 11 días



Ida

● Día 1 · UK - Night on board

· Arrive at the departure airport ready to board your flight to Arusha Airport. Night on board.

● Día 2 · Arusha

· Arrival at Kilimanjaro airport and transfer to Arusha, the most important city in the north of the country and "capital of the safari", being the main gateway and starting point for different wild expeditions. Overnight stay in Arusha.

● Día 3 · Arusha - Tarangire

· Breakfast at the hotel. Leave for the Tarangire National Park named after the river that crosses through it. It hosts the highest concentration of wildlife outside the Serengeti ecosystem. After lunch, in the afternoon, embark on an exciting safari to discover its wildlife and dream landscapes with lagoons and baobabs. Leave the park and travel along the shore of Lake Manyara to your hotel. Arrival, dinner and accommodation.

● Día 4 · Tarangire - Lake Manyara - Ngorongoro

· Breakfast at the hotel. In the morning take a safari walk through Lake Burunge, whose waters attract many species of beautiful birds. Enjoy a picnic lunch before you enter Lake Manyara National Park for an afternoon safari, to enjoy a great variety of African wildlife such as hippos, buffalo, elephants, giraffes and lions, who love to rest in the branches of acacia trees. Transfer to your camp in Ngorongoro for dinner and overnight stay.

● Día 5 · Ngorongoro - Karatu

· Breakfast at the hotel. Descend to the Crater for a Crater Tour with a picnic lunch. Late afternoon exit the Crater for a country Lodge in the adjoining Karatu area, for dinner and overnight.

● Día 6 · Karatu - Arusha - Zanzibar

· Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Kilimanjaro airport to board your flight to Zanzibar. Arrive at the island, transfer to the hotel to enjoy the outstanding facilities and the gorgeous ocean views. Dinner and overnight stay.

● Día 7 · Zanzibar

· Breakfast at the hotel. We recommend spending the day discovering Stone Town, the city centre of the main island. Here you can admire the mixture of architecture which dates back to the 19th century and reveals the diversity of Swahili culture. Not to be missed is the Anglican Cathedral, constructed in the 1870s and still home to Sunday morning services. Dinner and overnight stay.

● Día 8 · Zanzibar

· Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy another day at leisure. If you still haven't caught a glimpse of the native sea turtle, we recommend a visit to the Mnarani Aquarium. This aquarium rescues turtles that are caught in fishing nets and protects newly hatched turtles from predators as they make their journey to the sea. Dinner and overnight stay.

● Día 9 · Zanzibar

· Breakfast at the hotel. Spend your last day soaking up the sun and relaxing on the white sands. If you are looking for a little more culture we would recommend a visit to the Beit el-Ajaib (House of Wonders), which is said to be the grandest building in Zanzibar. Here you can marvel at the gigantic carved doors and find out more about Swahili culture and life on the Indian Ocean at the museum of National History and Culture, which is housed inside. Dinner and overnight stay.

● Día 10 · Zanzibar - UK

· Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport ready to check-in for a return flight back to the UK. Night on board.

● Día 11 · UK

· Arrival back in the UK. End of your trip.
