Detalles del viaje: 14 días

Ida

● **Día 1** · UK - Delhi

● Arrival at UK departure airport ready to check-in for flight to Delhi. Night on board.

● **Día 2** · Delhi

● Arrival in the capital of India and transfer to hotel. Delhi is a city with an impressive architectural legacy of its Islamic conquerors along with a spectacular historical centre. Rest of the day free to rest or to get to know this lively, fascinating city. Overnight in Delhi.

● **Día 3** · Delhi

● Breakfast at the hotel. Visit Old Delhi including the Jama Masjid Royal Mosque and the lively Chandni Chowk Street. Ride a tricycle around Red Fort, former residence of the Imperial Family and admire the Raj Ghat, where Mahatma Gandhi was cremated. In the afternoon, explore New Delhi, passing through the India Gate, the Mausoleum of Emperor Humayun, government buildings and the Presidential Palace. Overnight in Delhi.

● **Día 4** · Delhi - Jaipur

● Breakfast at the hotel. Leave by road to Jaipur, the Pink City of India. Capital of Rajasthan, Jaipur was built in 1728 by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II. Its architecture is a magnificent confluence of Hindu, Jain and Mughal architectural styles. Arrive and transfer to the hotel. Rest of the day free to get to know this vibrant city. Overnight in Jaipur.

● **Día 5** · Jaipur

● Breakfast at the hotel. Explore the Amber fort on the backs of elephants. In the interior, cross the premises of the palace Jag Mandir and the famous Sheesh Mahal, a room embedded with beautifully bright pieces of mirror. Tour the city of Jaipur including a visit to the Palace of the Maharaja City, former royal residence, part of it converted into a museum. Also experience the wonder of the Jantar Mantar, the largest observatory in the world made of marble. Overnight at hotel.

● **Día 6** · Jaipur - Fatehpur Sikri - Agra

● Breakfast at the hotel. Leave Jaipur for Agra and along the way visit Fatehpur Sikri, an impressive ghost town. Next, pass by Buland Darwaza, the largest gateway in the world. Arrive in Agra and visit a UNESCO World Heritage site, the Agra Fort. Inside the fort discover the picturesque Pearl Mosque. Overnight in Agra.

● **Día 7** · Agra - Delhi

● Breakfast at the hotel, then visit the magnificent and unmissable Taj Mahal, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It was built in white marble by Shah Jahan, in memory of his beautiful woman Mumtaz Mahal. In addition to its imposing design and perfect symmetry, the Taj Mahal is also known for its elegant domes and its superb works of carved wood and incrustations. Transfer to Delhi and overnight stay in hotel.

● **Día 8** · Delhi - Cochin

● Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to the airport for your flight to Cochin. Arrive in Cochin and transfer to your hotel. After acclimatising to this vibrant city, known as 'God's Own Country', embark on an afternoon of sightseeing. Enjoy the walking tour that takes you to a number of the most captivating sites in the city, including the historic Fort Kochi, the beautiful Jewish Quarter and the Dutch Palace. End up on the peninsula where you will see the famous 'Chinese fishing nets', which pays homage to an ancient fishing technique that is fascinating to watch. Return to your hotel for an overnight stay.

● **Día 9** · Cochin - Munnar

● Breakfast at hotel before you set off for charming Munnar. Set in the stunning Western Ghats mountain range, Munnar is sure to leave you enchanted. On the way, visit the Athirapally Waterfalls, a popular tourist attraction. The waterfalls are a height of 80 feet and set in an area of lush greenery and surrounded by the spectacular Sholayar hills. Arrive in Munnar, check in to your hotel and enjoy an overnight stay.

● **Día 10** · Munnar - Kumarakom

● Breakfast at the hotel. After breakfast, proceed to visit the Munnar Tea Museum, an unspoiled area of lush green hills, covered with large plantations of tea, coffee and cardamom and has some of the most breathtakingly beautiful scenic spots. Learn about the most interesting aspects of tea cultivation and learn about the flourishing tea trade in the region. Also visit the stunning Church of Christ, which was built in 1910 by the British and is renowned for its unique location, on a rocky outcrop, and its stunning architecture. Later, drive to Kumarakom, set in the Kerala backwaters where you can admire the majestic canals

and water systems and enjoy a tour of a local Spice Plantation, to understand the uses and significance of the variety of spices grown in the region. Overnight in Kumarakom.

● **Día 11** · Kumarakom

Breakfast at your hotel. Spend another day at your leisure, soaking up the peaceful atmosphere of this region. Alternatively, we recommend you take an option excursion to the town of Kottayam, a centre of Indian literature, known as the Land of Letters. Overnight stay at your hotel. *Depart by motorboat, and then by road, for a half day tour of the town of Kottayam, for a day of culture and fascinating history. Visit the important local churches of Cheriya Palli & Valiya Palli, which are of both Persian and Christian significance, respectively. Also discover the impressive temple of Thrunakkara, which is among the most popular in the region due to the striking colours of the towering shrines, which are dedicated to the Hindu god, Shiva. Later, explore the town centre, which was home to the first vernacular printing press in the country, before returning to Kumarakom. Price per person £24.

● **Día 12** · Kumarakom - Marari

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Marari. Arrive at your hotel and spend the day at your leisure. This beach resort is the perfect antidote to a busy life, with quiet beaches with white sands, lush foliage and charming local wildlife. Watch the ocean lapping at the shore or enjoy a stroll around the vast resort. Overnight stay.

● **Día 13** · Marari

Breakfast at your hotel. Make the most of a day to yourself by visiting the local fishing village or unwinding with an Ayurveda or spa treatment at the hotel. Perhaps enjoy watching the sun set over the horizon on the beach after a day of complete tranquility. Overnight stay.

● **Día 14** · Marari - Cochin - UK

Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to Cochin Airport for your return flight back to the UK. Arrival in UK and end of your trip.
