Ida

● Día 1 · UK - Overnight

· Arrival at UK departure airport ready for departure airport to Rio de Janeiro. Night on board.

● Día 2 · Rio de Janeiro

· On arrival in Rio de Janeiro, transfer to the hotel and the rest of the day is free for you to explore this sprawling city, full of colonial architecture and vibrant culture. We recommend a stroll along Rio's famous beaches, Copacabana and Ipanema. Overnight in Rio de Janeiro.

● Día 3 · Rio de Janeiro

· Breakfast at hotel. Spend the day taking a city tour of wonderful Rio, which includes a trip up to the famous Christ the Redeemer statue. Visit the famous Corcovado mountain, one of the Seven Wonders of the Modern World. Christ Redeemer is more than 700m in height and dominates the city's skyline. Admire the iconic Christ the Redeemer; an immense rock statue built by the sculptor Francés Paul Landowski. Descend from the hills to enjoy a visit to Maracanã and a visit to the Sambódromo, where the Rio Carnival takes place yearly. Overnight in Rio de Janeiro.

● Día 4 · Rio de Janeiro

· Breakfast at hotel. Spend the day at your leisure and explore the city at your own pace for a taste of Brazilian life. Overnight in Rio de Janeiro.

● Día 5 · Rio de Janeiro - Iguazú

· Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to the airport for a flight to Iguazú. Transfer to your hotel and the rest of the day is free. If the arrival time allows, we suggest enjoying a bike ride through the jungle or rest in this beautiful natural setting. Overnight in hotel.

● Día 6 · Iguazú

· Breakfast at hotel. Today visit the Brazilian side of the Iguazú Falls, one of the world's Seven Natural Wonders. Walk across bridges and enjoy the panoramic views on offer. Hear the roar of water whilst contemplating spectacular views of rainbows, birds, leafy green exotic plants and trees. Return to the hotel for an overnight stay.

● Día 7 · Iguazú

· Breakfast at the hotel. Visit the Argentinian side of Iguazu Falls by taking the train to the 'Devil's Throat' where a lookout area grants the opportunity to watch the water rush from the river and down an 80 metre (262 feet) high sheer drop. Walk across bridges and enjoy the panoramic views on offer. Hear the roar of water whilst contemplating spectacular views of rainbows, birds, leafy green exotic plants and trees. Return to the hotel for an overnight stay.

● Día 8 · Iguazú - Manaus

· Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the hotel for flight to Manaus. On arriving in Manaus, check in to the hotel and enjoy a free day to relax or we suggest taking a trip to Ponta Negra beach. Take a stroll along the boardwalk and marvel at the beautiful contrast between the golden sands and black waters of the Rio Negro. A perfect place to watch the sunset. Overnight at the hotel.

● Día 9 · Manaus - Amazon

· Breakfast at the hotel. Take an exciting transfer into the Amazon rainforest, and be sure to keep an eye out for the vibrant wildlife found in this area. Arrive at the Amazon Lodge and enjoy an evening at your leisure. Overnight stay and Dinner.

● Día 10 · Amazon

· Full-Board. We recommend taking one of the varied and informative excursions on offer at the lodge to further explore the rainforest eco-system and the beautiful wildlife and fauna. Enjoy a boat ride on the Amazon river and perhaps embark on a trek through the rainforest, try some canoeing, go alligator watching or embark on a sunrise excursion to watch the tropical birds sing their morning songs. Overnight stay.

● Día 11 · Amazon - Manaus -Sao Paulo

After breakfast , transfer back to Manaus for a flight to Sao Paulo. Arrive in Sao Paulo, the vibrant financial centre of Brazil, home to plenty of cultural delights and wonderful architecture. Spend the remainder of the day at your leisure. Overnight stay.

● Día 12 · Sao Paulo

Breakfast at the hotel. Today, spend your time exploring the city at your own pace, or alternatively, we suggest taking our optional city tour for a comprehensive overview of all the Sao Paulo has to offer.* Overnight stay. *Optional Excursion: Take a trip through the history and culture of São Paulo and discover the many facets of this cosmopolitan and dynamic city. Begin with a visit to the centre of São Paulo, and the Metropolitan Cathedral, whose organ has more than 10,000 pipes and it is home to an underground chapel and crypt. Admire the modern part of the city at the Banco do Brasil Cultural Center and after this small immersion in the Brazilian culture, visit the first aqueduct in the city: the Viaduto do Chá, whose name originated from the tea that once grew in the valley below. After this rich and fascinating day, you can stop at the Municipal Market, to recharge your batteries by tasting the local delicacies. £65 per person.

● Día 13 · Sao Paulo -Night on board

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport for a flight back to the UK. Night on board.

● Día 14 · UK

Arrive in the UK and end your trip.
