Ida

● **Día 1** · España - Noche a bordo

Presentación en el aeropuerto para embarcar en vuelo con destino Sandakan. Noche a bordo.

● **Día 2** · Sandakan

Llegada a Sandakan y traslado al hotel. Resto del día libre para empezar a descubrir esta impresionante ciudad. Alojamiento.

● **Día 3** · Sandakan

After breakfast, embark on your adventure, the full day Sepilok / Sun Bear & Sandakan City tour, with a drive to Sepilok Orang-Utan Rehabilitation Centre where orphaned and injured Orang-Utan are brought to Sepilok to be rehabilitated and then returned to the wild to fend for themselves. Sepilok is a primary lowland forest; a fine showcase of Borneo's remaining rainforest. Witness the feeding of Orang-Utan from a platform in the forest. Watch the 25 minutes scheduled video documentary show. Proceed to Borneo Sun Bear Conservation Centre (BSBCC) and witness the effort to provide for the care, rehabilitation and release of orphaned and captive sun bears, as well as address the lack of knowledge and awareness of this little-known bear both in Malaysia and internationally. The Malayan sun bears (*Helarctos malayanus*), are found only in south-east Asia, and is the world's smallest bear species. Stop at a local restaurant for lunch and at 2:00 PM proceed for a city tour and explore the various landmarks of Sandakan, which may include the Central Market, the most amazing variety of fresh seafood and agricultural products, Sim-Sim Water Village where houses are all built close to the water surface while observing the fascinating view of the sea. Visit Puh Jih Syh Buddhist Temple which offers a panoramic view of Sandakan Bay situated on the hilltop of Tanah Merah. After the tour, drop off at your hotel. Evening at leisure.

● **Día 4** · Sandakan

Day at leisure to explore the surrounding areas or go on an optional tour. Overnight on a bed and breakfast basis in Sandakan. **TOUR EX-SANDAKAN: GOMANTONG CAVE & SUKAU (KINABATANGAN WILDLIFE SANCTUARY) DAY TRIP** PRICE (SIC): 133 eur per pax (min 2 pax) Package Includes: English speaking guide, land/boat transfers based on joining basis, entrance fees and meals as stated Package Excludes: Camera/video camera fees, airfares/taxes/insurance and beverages (alcoholic/carbonate/juice) Meet & greet by guide at hotel or airport and drive for about 2.5hrs drive through rustic countryside studded with villages. Explore one of the fascinating cave in Sabah, which is home to the millions of bats and swiftlets. The swiftlets made the famous Chinese edible bird's nest soup. Lunch at Borneo Nature Lodge. Time for orientation and relax by the river before embarking by boat up-river at 4:00 PM along Sabah's longest river, Kinabatangan with opportunity to view wildlife and birds in its virgin rainforest habitat. Search for some of the primate species including the endemic Proboscis Monkeys as they settle down on treetops. Kinabatangan Wildlife Sanctuary is on the best places in Southeast Asia to observe wildlife. After cruise drive back to Sandakan and drop at hotel or airport. Meal Included: Lunch Recommended Personal Gear: Insect repellent, raincoat (umbrella not recommended), flash light, hat, binocular and sun screen (sweat proof). Use good walking shoes and comfortable cotton T-shirt with long or short pants.

● **Día 5** · Sandakan - Kuala Lumpur

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to Kuala Lumpur

● **Día 6** · Kuala Lumpur

Desayuno en el hotel . Hacemos tour de medio día con un guía de habla inglesa por la ciudad de Kuala Lumpur. Recorremos los símbolos más emblemáticos de la ciudad como las Torres Petronas, que fueron los edificios más altos del mundo entre 1998 y 2004, el Palacio Real, la impresionante Casa del Parlamento, los Jardines del Lago, la Mezquita Nacional y la vieja estación de tren hasta llegar a la Plaza de la Independencia. Visita opcional al Museo Nacional que recoge la historia y la cultura de Malasia. Finalmente disfrutamos de un animado paseo por Chinatown. Alojamiento.

● **Día 7** · Kuala Lumpur

Desayuno en el hotel. Traslado al aeropuerto para embarcar en el vuelo con destino a Langkawi. Llegada a Langkawi. Traslado al hotel de Langkawi y alojamiento. Langkawi es un archipiélago de Malasia que se encuentra en el mar de Andamán y cuenta con más 104 islas. Ofrece una excelente oportunidad para visitar las idílicas playas y la naturaleza del lugar. Langkawi is an archipelago of 104 islands in the Andaman Sea with only 99 islands at high tide! On 1 June 2007, Langkawi Island was given a World Geopark status by UNESCO. Three of its main conservation areas in Langkawi Geopark are Machincang Cambrian Geoforest Park, Kilim Karst Geoforest Park and Dayang Bunting Marble Geoforest park (Island of the Pregnant Maiden Lake). These three parks are the most popular tourism area within Langkawi Geopark. Upon arrival at Langkawi International Airport, you will be met at the arrival hall by a representative.

● **Día 8** · Langkawi

After breakfast, embark on your Evergreen Mangrove & Cave Exploration which is a tour of the Kilim Nature Park, spread over an area of 100 sq km. It features a beautiful mix of well-protected green mangrove forests, isolated white beaches and blue lagoons. The mangrove adventure, cave exploring, eagle watching and a delicious lunch will most definitely appease all your senses. This is an adventurous tour requiring climbing of steep stairs and uneven paths, so a pair of

good walking shoes is recommended. Towels will come handy. If you have a torch light bring it along. A pair of binoculars will prove rewarding. Take a walk on the platforms and see the variety of fish that are separated by net cages. Get a close-up shot of the many eagles as they zoom down with accuracy to their feed. See the vampire bats having their siesta as hundreds of them cling upside down from the ceiling of the cave formed millions of years ago. For nature lovers, the formation of stalagmite and stalactite including the rock formation would serve as an interesting subject. Return to your hotel in the late afternoon.

● Día 9 · Langkawi

Desayuno. Free day The pace of life in Langkawi is more laid back and relaxing so you can choose to sunbathe and swim at the resort's pool or beach or you can choose more exciting things to do, such as going on an island hopping excursion where you will visit 3 islands. Or take the cable car up Mat Chinchang Mountain and enjoy a fabulous view of the island and surrounding islands, walk along the Sky Bridge to the viewing point where you can see Thailand, on a good day. **OPTIONAL TOUR HIGHLIGHTS OF LANGKAWI PRICE (SIC): 22 eur per pax (min 2 pax)** Places of visit includes a cable car ride to one of the highest mountain in Langkawi, a magnificent cultural craft complex and Eagle Square, the proud landmark of Langkawi. An option to shop at Kuah Town and venture your way back to your Resort. Eagle Square - see the magnificent Eagle Sculpture erected on a pedestal overlooking the sea. The huge monument costing over 2 million ringgit is a tribute to the Island, which is named after brown eagle. Cable Car - a 15-minute glide through virgin rainforest and waterfall to the peak of Gunung Mat Chincang. Feel on top of the World - breathe in the cool air as your eyes sweep the dramatic "bird-eye" view of Langkawi Islands and more. Kompleks Kraf Budaya - a magnificent complex nestled on a hillside overlooking the sea, visitors are offered a wide range of Malaysian handicraft such as delicate hand drawn batik and intricately carved silverware. Enroute pass scenic paddy fields with groups of buffaloes resting in their muddy ponds. Quaint Malay 'kampungs' (villages) are scattered all over the Island, giving you a true insight into the architectural design of genuine Malay homes. Kuah Town is a bustling shopping center. There are shopping complexes for fixed priced items and street stalls to browse, haggle and buy your best bargains. Note: • Routing of tour is subject to pick-up point. • Cable Car ride is subject to weather conditions. EXCLUDES entrance fee to Cable Car ride. The Cable Car closes periodically for their Monthly & Yearly Preventive Maintenance Work at the discretion of the management of Cable Car. During this period, visit to cable car will be replaced with options of Laman Padi or Lagenda Park. Laman Padi - The Rice Museum, with the most comprehensive exhibition centre displaying artefacts, charts, photographs as well as actual rice-planting tools. Lagenda Park - This is a scenic park with beautiful gardens of vivid local blooms, plants and trees. It has been designed and landscaped with exhibits detailing the myths and legends of the island in mini sculptures and statues. It houses 17 monuments, each with an intriguing story to tell and visitors can refer to the story board / label located at each places. Open daily from 09:00am - 07:00pm.
