### Detalles del viaje: 21 días



#### Ida

#### ● Día 1 · UK - Night on board

● Arrival at UK departure airport ready to check-in for a flight to Buenos Aires. Night on board.

#### ● Día 2 · Buenos Aires

● Arrive in Buenos Aires a sprawling city, full of colonial architecture and vibrant culture. Spend the day getting to know this exciting city at your leisure. Overnight stay.

#### ● Día 3 · Buenos Aires

● Breakfast at hotel. Spend the day exploring the charming corners of the city on a fascinating city tour. The city is known as the birthplace of the Tango. Explore the contrasting neighbourhoods: the colourful houses of La Boca, the culture of La Recoleta, the old town, San Telmo or the young, vibrant neighbourhood of Puerto Madero. Overnight stay at the hotel in Buenos Aires.

#### ● Día 4 · Buenos Aires - El Calafate

● Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport for a flight to El Calafate, a town near the edge of the unique region of Southern Patagonia, and home to the huge Perito Moreno glacier. Spend the day at your leisure exploring the town and sampling the unique cuisine of this other-worldly region. Overnight in El Calafate.

#### ● Día 5 · El Calafate

● Breakfast at the hotel. Journey to Perito Moreno, the most famous glacier in the world. On arrival at Los Glaciares National Park view Lake Argentino, Argentina's biggest freshwater lake and visit the 'cuerva de los suspiros', the curve of sighs. From here it is possible to contemplate El Perito Moreno. Stroll along the walkways in front of the glacier to see this spectacular ice mass from different perspectives. We suggest taking the optional excursion, a mini trek on the glacier\* Return to El Calafate and overnight in hotel. \*Optional: Get up close to Perito Moreno on an exhilarating hike and walk on the glacier itself! £165 per person

#### ● Día 6 · El Calafate

● Breakfast at the hotel. Free day to enjoy the surroundings or do some shopping. We suggest taking an optional excursion to Upsala glacier \*. Overnight in hotel. \* Optional: Visit Upsala Glacier in Los Glaciares National Park, the third longest in South America. £145 per person.

#### ● Día 7 · El Calafate - Iguazú

● Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport for flight to Iguazu, home of the mighty Iguazu Falls! Take the day at your leisure and if the arrival time allows, we suggest enjoying a bike ride through the jungle or rest in this beautiful natural setting. Overnight in hotel.

#### ● Día 8 · Iguazú Falls

● Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy a full day on the Argentinian side of the Iguazu Falls. Discover one of the greatest creations of Mother Nature from the green train which transports you to two trails. Start on the upper trail following 800 metres of suspended walkways and a view of the falls from above. Then continue to the lower trail and discover the suspended footbridges alongside the falls. We suggest our optional excursion which will take you on a boat right under the waterfalls to get an up-close perspective of the falls.\* Overnight at the hotel \*Optional Grand Adventure boat ride. £55 per person.

#### ● Día 9 · Iguazu Falls

● Breakfast at the hotel. Take an excursion to the waterfalls on the Brazilian side of the border for a different perspective of this wonder of nature and for a chance to see some unforgettable panoramic views of the thundering falls and the lush landscapes that surround them. Return to the Argentinian side for your overnight stay.

#### ● Día 10 · Iguazú Falls - Buenos Aires

● Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport to board a flight to Buenos Aires. Spend the afternoon to further discover the vibrant capital and take the opportunity to enjoy an optional Tango Dinner Show.\* Overnight in Buenos Aires. \* Optional: An immersive evening of Argentinian food and arts at the Dinner and Tango Show. £85 per person.

#### ● Día 11 · Buenos Aires - Lima

Transfer to the airport for the flight to Lima. Arrival in Lima and get some rest before starting to explore this wonderful city.

### ● Día 12 · Lima

Breakfast at the hotel. We suggest taking the optional excursion for £25\*. Overnight stay. \*Visit the districts of Miraflores and San Isidro. Enjoy the panoramic view of Huaca Huallamarca and visit the Sant Domingo Convent. Walk through Plaza Mayor which is surrounded by Arzobispal palace, the metropolitan municipality and the cathedral. Stop to try a traditional Pisco Sour. Finally, visit the the Larco museum whose artefacts display more than 3000 years of Pre-Columbian history. Overnight stay.

### ● Día 13 · Lima - Puno

Breakfast\* at the hotel. Take a flight from Lima's airport to Juliaca. Arrival to Juliaca and transfer to Puno. Overnight stay in Puno. \* Please note: if you have an early morning flight from Lima, your breakfast will be packed for you to have on the journey. Early morning passengers will be able to check-in upon arrival at the hotel in Puno to rest

### ● Día 14 · Puno

Breakfast at the hotel. Excursion to Taquile and Uros island. Depart to Taquile island - Taquile has remnants of the past which date back to pre-Inca times. The islanders are famous for their beautiful clothing, their incredible knits, and textile industry. Next, visit the community of Huayllano, on the same island, where the locals show their traditional crafts and agriculture. Lunch . Visit the islands of Uros situated in the middle of the national reserve of Lake Titicaca. Transfer to hotel. Overnight stay.

### ● Día 15 · Puno - Cuzco

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Puno station to take a bus to Cuzco. Leave the station and start your journey on the bus to Puno and enjoy the marvelous landscapes of the South Valley of Cuzco. Visit Andahuaylas, the beautiful church of 17 th century, featuring an impressive organ decorated with angels and cherubs. Later on, visit the ruins of Racqui, also known as the 'Temple of the God Wiracocha' and have lunch . Discover La Raya, the highest point on the highway between Cuzco and Puno for amazing views of the landscape. Arrival in Cuzco and transfer to hotel. Overnight stay.

### ● Día 16 · Cuzco - Machu Picchu - Aguas Calientes

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the train station of Cuzco. Your adventure starts on board the Expedition train heading towards Aguas Calientes. Upon arrival, head to Machu Picchu for an unforgettable experience. Once in Machu Picchu, you will be able to cover each corner of this seventh wonder of the world, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Return to the town of Aguas Calientes for lunch . Rest of the day is free. Dinner and overnight stay.\* \*Please note: for your overnight stay in Aguas Calientes, you will leave your main suitcases and baggage at the hotel in Cuzco and you are permitted to take only a small overnight rucksack or bag for the journey to Machu Picchu on the Expedition train.

### ● Día 17 · Aguas Calientes - Cuzco

Breakfast at the hotel. At the indicated time, return to Cuzco. Arrival and transfer to hotel and day free to explore the area.

### ● Día 18 · Cuzco

Breakfast at the hotel. We suggest taking the optional excursion for £45\*. Overnight stay. \*Begin the day at Chinchero, a small picturesque town home to the important archeological Inca site, constructed in the final years of the decade of 1400, a beautiful and traditional church. Visit "Urpi" a famous textile centre, where the town people have conserved the Andean spinning techniques of knitting. Visit Ollantaytambo a fort which also served as a temple. On your way to Ollantaytambo, stop by Racchi viewpoint for a stunning picturesque photographic opportunity. Afterwards, continue towards the town adjacent to Ollantaytambo, "the only alive Inca town" which hasn't been inhabited since the 13 th century.

### ● Día 19 · Cuzco

Breakfast at the hotel. You are free to spend the day at your leisure and explore the former Capital of the Incas.

### ● Día 20 · Cuzco - UK

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Cuzco airport for your flight back to the UK. Night on board.

### ● Día 21 · UK

Arrival at UK airport and end of your trip.
