Ida

● **Día 1** · UK - Night on Board

· Arrive at UK departure airport, ready to board your flight to Kuala Lumpur. Night on board.

● **Día 2** · Kuala Lumpur

· Arrive in Kuala Lumpur and transfer to your hotel. Kuala Lumpur is home to many iconic skyscrapers, such as the Petronas Towers, amazing street food and endless charm. Get out and start discovering this modern, yet traditional, city. Overnight in Kuala Lumpur

● **Día 3** · Kuala Lumpur

· Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy a half day English speaking tour of Kuala Lumpur. Experience a photo stop at the most emblematic symbols of the city such as the Petronas Towers which were the tallest buildings in the world between 1998 and 2004, the Royal Palace, the impressive Parliament House, the Lake Gardens, the National Mosque and the old train station, before you reach the Plaza Independence. We suggest an optional visit to the National Museum which displays the history and culture of Malaysia. Enjoy a lively evening stroll through Chinatown. Overnight stay.

● **Día 4** · Kuala Lumpur - Ubud

· Breakfast at hotel. Spend the day further exploring Kuala Lumpur before you transfer to the airport for your flight to Ubud. Arrive in Ubud and transfer to your hotel. Ubud is an excitingly vibrant town in the centre of Bali and is known to be a trendy and bohemian place with plenty of delicious dining options. Overnight in Ubud.

● **Día 5** · Ubud

· Breakfast at hotel. Today discover Balinese culture through a tour of the island. Start with a drive towards Singapadu village to take a closer look at a Balinese compound with its authentic design and architecture. Continue through Mas with a stop at wood carvers and mask makers workshop. Strike a conversation with these devoted local artisans before continuing along the road to arrive at the Sacred Monkey Forest, home of long-tailed Macaques. Next, visit the Pura Saraswati temple with its unique and beautiful architecture. Pura Saraswati was devoted to "Dewi Saraswati" the goddess of learning, literature and the arts. The day closed with a walk around the Ubud Market, where you can shop for art products at competitive prices; don't forget to bargain! Return to your hotel in Ubud for an overnight stay.

● **Día 6** · Ubud

· Breakfast at the hotel. Spend the day at your leisure, discovering the lush rainforests or relaxing, pool-side. Overnight stay.

● **Día 7** · Ubud - Legian

· Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to your hotel in Legian. Free day to enjoy this oasis of tranquility, located in the southern region of Bali and famous for its breathtaking sunrises. Arrival at the hotel and overnight stay.

● **Día 8** · Legian

· Breakfast at the hotel. Get picked up from your hotel to visit the Royal Family temple known as Taman Ayun located in Mengwi. The temple was built in 1634, by a king of Mengwi dynasty. An impressive complex on a small island surrounded by a hand made lake. Continue to Alas Kedaton, a megalithic sacred temple in a forest inhabited by thousands of monkeys and hundreds of big bats. Next, to Bali's most photographed temple, Tanah Lot. Perched on a little rocky islet that is inaccessible during high tides. In this temple where usually people will discover the most dramatic sunset on Bali's island. You will be taken back to your hotel. Overnight stay.

● **Día 9** · Legian

· Breakfast at the hotel. Free day. We recommend visiting the Uluwatu Temple, one of the most emblematic monuments of Bali located high on a cliff in an impressive coastal rainforest. You cannot miss the beautiful sunset over the Indian Ocean from here. Overnight stay.

● **Día 10** · Legian

· Breakfast at the hotel. Continue to enjoy the eternal beaches of clear sand and warm waters. We recommend water activities and enjoying the hotel spa. Overnight stay.

● **Día 11** · Legian - Denpasar - Night on board

⋮ Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Denpasar airport for your flight back to the UK. Night on board.
