● Día 1 · UK- Zimbabwe

● Arrival at UK departure airport ready to check-in for an overnight flight to Zimbabwe

● Día 2 · Zimbabwe

● Arrive in Zimbabwe at Victoria Falls and transfer to the hotel. Enjoy sunset cruise on the mighty Zambezi River. You have the opportunity of spotting a variety of animals on the cruise, such as hippo, crocodile and elephants whilst you enjoy sunset snacks and drinks on board. Watch the sun fall behind the African horizon and return to the hotel for an overnight stay.

● Día 3 · Zimbabwe

● Breakfast at the hotel. Today visit the awe-inspiring UNESCO World Heritage Site of Victoria Falls. Described locally as 'The Smoke That Thunders', Victoria Falls sits at the south of the Zambezi river, between Zimbabwe and Zambia. Be guided through the rainforest and explore the native flora and fauna before arriving at the waterfall. Enjoy time being amazed by the power of the falls and visit different vantage points, for an unforgettable experience. Return to the hotel for an overnight stay.

● Día 4 · Zimbabwe

● Breakfast at the hotel. Spend the day at your leisure or take our optional safari and river cruise in the Chobe National Park.* Overnight stay. *Optional: Set off on an exciting full-day excursion to the Chobe National Park in Botswana. Cruise along the Chobe River, and spot the local game before enjoying a river-side lunch. In the afternoon, embark on a safari game drive in the Chobe National Park, known for its large herds of elephants and wandering prides of lions. Take in the spectacular landscapes and wildlife before returning to Zimbabwe for an overnight stay. Price per person: £128.10

● Día 5 · Zimbabwe - Cape Town

● Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport for a flight to Cape Town. Arrive and transfer to your hotel. Take the chance to explore this wonderful port city, which not only offers a plethora of culinary options, that reflect the city's diversity but was also crowned World Design Capital in 2014. Overnight stay in Cape Town.

● Día 6 · Cape Town

● Breakfast at the hotel. Today enjoy a city tour and Table Mountain excursion. Get to know the city's history and landmarks before heading up to Table Mountain, by cable car, for an unforgettable experience. This flat-topped mountain is the most characteristic symbol of Cape Town and provides breathtaking views of the city and surrounding landscape. Return to Cape Town for an overnight stay.

● Día 7 · Cape Town

● Breakfast at the hotel. Embark on a full day tour to the Cape of Good Hope and Cape Winelands: a drive that has been described as one of the most spectacular drives in the world. Pass by Hout Bay, Noordhoek Beach, Boulders Penguin Colony and the Cape Point Nature Reserve, to mention but a few. At the Penguin Colony be enchanted by these charming creatures and enjoy a stop to watch the families of penguins interact with each other. Marvel at the biodiversity and the lush landscapes that surround the area and enjoy entrance into Kirstenbosch National Botanical Gardens. At the Cape of Good Hope, you are at one of the most southerly points of this beautiful continent, where you can gaze out at the meeting point of the Indian and Atlantic Oceans and appreciate the historical significance of this Natural World Heritage site. Return to Cape Town for an overnight stay.

● Día 8 · Cape Town

● Breakfast at the hotel. Spend the day at your leisure, or alternatively, we recommend an optional adventure to dive with the white shark on a cage or enjoy a whale watching boat trip.* Overnight stay. * Optional Great White shark cage diving experience: For the brave hearted, embark on an adventure dive and get up close to one of nature's most amazing creatures on a caged dive. Price per person: £152.50 *Optional Whale watching boat trip: Embark on an exciting boat trip to the whale-watching hot-spots around the coast and see nature's giants in the wild. Price per person: £110

● Día 9 · Cape Town - Mauritius

● Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport to board a flight to Mauritius. Arrive and transfer to the hotel. This island paradise is famous for its crystalline waters, white sands, exotic vegetation and idyllic corners. Accommodation in Mauritius.

● Día 10 · Mauritius

Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy your free day. We suggest visiting the Grand Bassin, an impressive lake located in a crater in the south of the island. It is the most important sacred place of worship for practitioners of the Hindu religion in Mauritius where you can enjoy the whole essence of Indian culture and customs. Why not take our optional full day Tea Route tour for an interesting insight into the islands tea heritage.* Dinner and overnight in Mauritius. * Optional full-day Tea Route tour: Awaken your sense as you following the tea trail across the island and learn the tea cultivation techniques that have been in use for centuries here. Visit Curepipe, before heading to the mighty Trou-aux Cerfs, a dormant volcanic crater, situated high above the city At the colonial estate of Domaine des Aubineaux, stroll the gardens and admire the tea plantations before stopping for a well-deserved tea break where you can sample the fresh teas on offer here. Head to the Bois Cheri tea factory to unearth the history of its production here and taste the many exotic teas now produced by the factory. Lastly, Saint Aubin's House will amaze you. A vanilla orchid plantation awaits in the gardens and the tour continues to the on-site rum distillery where you can taste the produce. Enjoy lunch on the balcony of the colonial house overlooking the beautiful estate. Price per person: £150

● Día 11 · Mauritius

Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy your free day. We recommend visiting the Chamarel Waterfall, the most beautiful waterfall on the island. Its beautiful fall, about 150 meters high, is surrounded by lush vegetation and a great variety of tropical plants. Also, don't miss out on our optional excursion to Port Louis for a city tour.* Dinner and overnight in Mauritius. * Optional half-day city tour of Port Louis: visit magnificent Port Louis to uncover the vibrant history and multiculturalism of Mauritius. Notice the different temples, mosques and churches as you tour the city and visit the main square, Plaza d'Armes, the Government House and the Municipal Theatre. Visit the beautiful waterfront and enjoy the French colonial architecture of this colourful city. Price per person: £62.50

● Día 12 · Mauritius

Breakfast at the hotel. We suggest visiting a traditional market to get a closer look at Mauritian culture. The best known are the markets of Port Louis or Quatre Bornes, where you can find a myriad of traditional dishes, vibrant coloured textiles and spices. We recommend a full-day optional tour to Port Louis and the North of the island.* Dinner and overnight in Mauritius. *Optional Full Day Port Louis & North tour : Head to Port Louis and enjoy the lively waterfront, the main craft market and Fort Adelaide, built by the British in 1835. Next, visit an old Sugar Mill for exciting rum tasting and learn about the history of trade on the island. Stop at the spectacular botanical gardens of Pamplemousses, where you are blown away by nature's splendour. The gardens are home to giant water lilies, as big as three metres wide. Enjoy the afternoon in the beautiful gardens before returning to the hotel. Price per person: £93.75

● Día 13 · Mauritius

Breakfast at the hotel. We suggest visiting a traditional market to get a closer look at Mauritian culture. The best known are the markets of Port Louis or Quatre Bornes, where you can find a myriad of traditional dishes, vibrant coloured textiles and spices. Alternatively, take our optional full day tour to the Mystic South.* Dinner and overnight in Mauritius. *Optional Mystic South Tour: Visit the central town of Curepipe, home to luxurious architecture and a busy commercial hub, to see a different side of Mauritian life. Next, head to the mighty Trou-aux Cerfs, a dormant volcanic crater, situated high above the city. Head into the mountains to visit the Ganga Talao lake, secluded in the lush heart of the island and considered a sacred Hindu site. Learn about its religious significance before ending the day at the La Vanille Crocodile Park, set in lush greenery and home to crocodiles, giant tortoises and beautiful butterflies and flora. Price per person: £100

● Día 14 · Mauritius - UK

Breakfast at the hotel. Free time until the indicated time for the transfer to the airport. Embark on the flight back to the UK. Night on board.

● Día 15 · UK
