Ida

● Día 1 · UK - Night on board

● Arrival at UK departure airport ready for a flight to Rio de Janeiro. Overnight on board.

● Día 2 · Rio de Janeiro

● On arrival in Rio de Janeiro, transfer to the hotel and the rest of the day is free for you to explore this sprawling city, full of colonial architecture and vibrant culture. We recommend a stroll along Rio's famous beaches, Copacabana and Ipanema. Overnight in Rio de Janeiro.

● Día 3 · Rio de Janeiro

● Breakfast at hotel. Spend the day taking an included city tour of wonderful Rio and Corcovado Mountain, which includes a trip up to the famous Christ the Redeemer statue. Visit the famous Corcovado mountain, one of the Seven Wonders of the Modern World and where you can watch the city from afar and admire the view of Lagoa Rodrigo de Freitas. Christ Redeemer is more than 700m in height and dominates the city's skyline. Admire the iconic Christ the Redeemer; an immense rock statue built by the sculptor Francés Paul Landowski which celebrates the visit of Carioca. Descend from the hills to enjoy a visit to Maracanã and a visit to the Sambódromo, where the Rio Carnival takes place yearly. Soak up the vibrant atmosphere of this lively city. Overnight in Rio de Janeiro.

● Día 4 · Rio de Janeiro

● Breakfast at the hotel. Spend the day at your leisure, or alternatively, we recommend an optional excursion to Sugar Loaf Mountain, the famous Selaron Steps & Metropolitan Cathedral*. Overnight stay. * Optional Excursion to Sugar Loaf Mountain, the Selaron Steps & Metropolitan Cathedral: Enjoy an informative tour of downtown Rio before stopping at the Metropolitan Cathedral, built in a pyramidal form and seat of the Roman Catholic archdiocese in Rio. Next, admire the colourful Selaron steps and head for the neighbourhood of Urca where one of the largest symbols of the city is located: Sugar Loaf Mountain. Travel to the top on a cable car and enjoy the spectacular views of Rio-Niterói Bridge and Corcovado Mountain. Look down on Copacabana beach, the Santa Cruz fortress and several beaches of Niterói and be amazed at the sheer beauty and diversity of the Rio skyline. Price per person: £56.25

● Día 5 · Rio de Janeiro

● Breakfast at the hotel. Spend the day at your leisure, exploring the city at your own pace. We recommend enjoying the exciting cuisine in beach-side cafe's and restaurants and relaxing and people-watching by the sea at Ipanema or Copacabana. Overnight stay.

● Día 6 · Rio de Janeiro - Iguazú

● Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to the airport for a flight to Iguazú. Transfer to your hotel and the rest of the day is free. If the arrival time allows, we suggest enjoying a bike ride through the jungle or rest in this beautiful natural setting. Overnight in hotel.

● Día 7 · Iguazú

● Breakfast at hotel. Today enjoy an included visit to the Brazillian side of the Iguazú Falls, one of the world's Seven Natural Wonders. Follow a trail which winds its way through the wild rainforest. Arrive at the impressive falls and walk across bridges and enjoy the panoramic views on offer as you take an elevator to the perfect vantage point. Hear the roar of water whilst contemplating spectacular views of rainbows, birds, leafy green exotic plants and trees. Return to the hotel for an overnight stay.

● Día 8 · Iguazú

● Breakfast at the hotel. Spend the day at your leisure exploring the surrounding rainforest and natural landscape, or alternatively visit the Argentinian side of Iguazu Falls on an optional excursion.* Overnight stay at the hotel. * Optional Excursion to the Argentinian side of the Iguazu Falls: Take the train to the 'Devil's Throat' where a lookout area grants the opportunity to watch the water rush from the river and down an 80 metre (262 feet) high sheer drop. On the way, back from the falls stop at the "Three Borders" where you will see the junction of all three countries where Brazil, Argentina, and Paraguay meet!

● Día 9 · Iguazú - Manaus

● Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the hotel for flight to Manaus. On arriving in Manaus, check in to the hotel and enjoy a free day to relax or we suggest taking a trip to Ponta Negra beach. Take a stroll along the boardwalk and marvel at the beautiful contrast between the golden sands and black waters of the Rio Negro. A perfect place to watch the sunset. Overnight at the hotel.

● Día 10 · Manaus

Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy an included city tour of Manaus today and enjoy the laid-back atmosphere of the capital of the state of Amazonas. Discover the exclusive neighbourhood of Ponta Negra and stroll along the boardwalk before visiting the Amazon Opera House, a symbol of the prosperous era of rubber production in the area. Visit the sights of the city including many of its colonial style buildings before stopping at the Adolpho Lisboa Market where you can browse the many local products for a glimpse into the culture and traditions of the Amazonian people. Rest of the day at your leisure and overnight stay.

● **Día 11** · Manaus

Breakfast at the hotel. A day at your leisure to explore the town or head into the rainforest to discover the huge variety of wildlife. We recommend an optional riverboat trip into the Amazon.* Overnight in Manaus. *Optional River Boat Excursion: Take a boat down the Rio Negro to admire Manaus from a different perspective and to visit the 'Meeting of the Waters' point, which marks the meeting of the Negro & Solimoes Rivers and consequently where the two rivers join together to form the Amazon River. Head back up-river to visiting the Janauari Ecological Park to admire the giant Lilly Pads and a variety of other flora and fauna. Enjoy lunch upon a floating restaurant before visiting the handicraft stalls of the local community. Return to Manaus for an overnight stay.

● **Día 12** · Manaus - Salvador

After breakfast, transfer back to Manaus for a flight to Salvador. Arrive in Salvador, located in the Northern State of Bahia and known for its Portuguese influence and beautiful tropical beaches. Transfer to the hotel and spend the remainder of the day at your leisure. Overnight stay.

● **Día 13** · Salvador

Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy an engaging included city tour which will transport you back through time to uncover the fascinating history of this city and region. Begin at the Fort of Santo Antônio da Barra, the starting point of the most popular carnival route. Continue towards the Historic Center of Pelourinho for a pleasant walk through what is considered an area of cultural and historical significance. Visit churches, museums and the Jorge Amado Foundation, before taking the Lacerda Elevator for a panoramic view of the Bay of All Saints and the Low City. Overnight stay.

● **Día 14** · Salvador

Breakfast at the hotel. Spend the day at your leisure or alternatively, take an optional excursion to uncover the Wonders of the Bay of All Saints.* Overnight stay. * Optional Excursion Wonders of the Bay of All Saints: Head for the beautiful All Saints Bay and stop on two islands where you can enjoy a relaxing in the sea, or take part in exciting activities such as kayaking, stand up paddle and snorkelling. Price per person: £43.75

● **Día 15** · Salvador

Breakfast at the hotel. Spend the day at your leisure. We recommend discovering the city's Portuguese colonial architecture, enjoying its Afro-Brazilian culture and relaxing on its tropical beaches. Overnight in hotel.

● **Día 16** · Salvador

Breakfast at the hotel. Take the day at your leisure. We recommend shopping in the historic quarter, watching the street capoeira dancers and enjoying a cocktail on the beach as you watch the sun go down. Overnight in hotel.

● **Día 17** · Salvador - Sao Paulo

Breakfast at the hotel. At the indicated time transfer to the airport for a flight to Sao Paulo. Arrive in Sao Paulo, transfer to the hotel and spend the rest of the day exploring this vibrant financial centre which boasts modern architecture and a cosmopolitan atmosphere. Overnight in São Paulo

● **Día 18** · Sao Paulo

Breakfast at the hotel. Today, spend your time exploring the city at your own pace, or alternatively, we suggest taking our optional city tour for a comprehensive overview of all the Sao Paulo has to offer.* Overnight stay. * Optional Tour of Sao Paulo: Take a trip through the history and culture of São Paulo and discover the many facets of this cosmopolitan and dynamic city. Begin with a visit to the centre of São Paulo, and the Metropolitan Cathedral, whose organ has more than 10,000 pipes and it is home to an underground chapel and crypt. Admire the modern part of the city at the Banco do Brasil Cultural Center and after this small immersion in the Brazilian culture, visit the first aqueduct in the city: the Viaduto do Chá, whose name originated from the tea that once grew in the valley below. After this rich and fascinating day, you can stop at the Municipal Market, to recharge your batteries by tasting the local delicacies.

● **Día 19** · Sao Paulo - Night on board

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport for a flight back to the UK. Night on board.

● **Día 20** · UK

Arrival at UK airport and end of your trip.
