Ida

● **Día 1** · UK - Tel Aviv

· Arrive at your UK departure airport to board the flight to Tel Aviv. Arrive in Tel Aviv, home to beautiful beaches, fantastic 1930s Bauhaus architecture and famed for its fascinating museums and galleries. Discover at your own pace and overnight stay.

● **Día 2** · Tel-Aviv

· Breakfast at the hotel. Spend the day at your leisure, exploring the different neighbourhoods, beaches and sights of Tel Aviv. Alternatively, we recommend an optional excursion to Masada and the Dead Sea.* Overnight in Tel Aviv. *Optional Excursion to Masada & The Dead Sea: Experience the Dead Sea and the ancient ruins of Masada on a full-day tour. Ascend to King Herod's ancient mountain fortress of Masada, before floating in the mineral-rich Dead Sea waters. Price per person: £87.50

● **Día 3** · Tel Aviv - Jaffa - Caesarea - Haifa - Acre - Galilee

· Breakfast at the hotel. Depart for a brief visit to the city of Jaffa, the oldest and most historic part of Tel-Aviv. Continue along the coastal road to Caesarea, a Roman city from the time of King Herod, famous for its grand architecture and its port, whose importance lasted until the time of the Crusaders. Visit the Roman Theater, cross city and the aqueduct . Continue to Haifa, located on the side of Mount Carmel to enjoy a panoramic view of the city, the Bahai Temple and its famous Persian Gardens. Continue to Acre, to visit the fortified city of the Crusaders of medieval times , from where you can appreciate the walls of the ancient city. Continue towards the Galilee, transfer to the hotel and overnight stay.

● **Día 4** · Galilee – Nazareth - Tiberias

· Breakfast at the hotel. Depart from Galilee towards Nazareth. Visit the Basilica of the Annunciation and the Carpinteria de Jose. Continues following the Sea of Galilee towards Tiberias. In the afternoon, continue towards Tabgha to visit the place of the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes before heading to Capernahum, the most important ministry of the last four years of Jesus, to visit the Ancient Synagogue and the House of St. Peter. Next, the Mount of the Beatitudes , scene of the Sermon on the Mount will delight you in all its historic and religious significance. Finally, enjoy a brief visit to the Diamond Factory , the second most important industry in the country. Arrive in the city of Tiberias for an overnight stay.

● **Día 5** · Tiberias - Jordan Valley – Jerusalem

· Breakfast at the hotel. Leave Tiberias in the direction of Yardenit, the place of Jesus' baptism, on the banks of the Jordan River. Continue travelling through the Jordan Valley to Beit Shean, one of the main cities of the Greek Decapolis whose strategic importance, due to its geographical location, has lasted throughout history to this day. Visit the archaeological excavations located here . Travel through the Judean Desert towards Jerusalem, and pass by the city of Jerico where you are able to appreciate Temple Mount. Arrive in the sacred city of Jerusalem and overnight stay.

● **Día 6** · Jerusalem - Belen - Jerusalem

· Breakfast at the hotel. Set off on a visit to the New City of Jerusalem. Visit the Book Sanctuary in the Museum of Israel, where the manuscripts of the Dead Sea and the Model of the City of Jerusalem in the time of Jesus are on display. See the Hebrew University of Jerusalem before continuing towards Ein Karem, a picturesque neighbourhood on the outskirts of Jerusalem where you can visit the Sanctuary of San Juan Bautista. From there we will continue to the Yad Vashem Memorial, a memorial to the 6 million Jews who perished in the Holocaust. In the afternoon, travel to Belen. Visit the Church and Grotto of the Nativity and the Chapels of San Jerónimo and San Jose. Return to Jerusalem for an overnight stay.

● **Día 7** · Jerusalem

· Breakfast at the hotel. Set off, via Mount Scopus, towards the Mount of Olives. Enjoy a panorama view of the Holy Walled City . Continue to the Garden of Gethsemani and the Basilica of the Agony. Head back towards the Old City to visit the Western Wall , a place of monumental significance to many religions around the world. Visit the Church of the Holy Sepulcher and then discover Mount Zion to visit the Tomb of King David, the Cenacle (Hall of the Last Supper) and the Abbey of the Dormition. Overnight in Jerusalem.

● **Día 8** · Jerusalem -Allenby Bridge - Amman.

· Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer from Jerusalem to Amman via the Allenby Bridge, where you can expect breathtaking scenery. Amman is the modern capital of Jordan but possesses dozens of ancient historical sites, all set in the north of Jordan on a hillside. Arrive and transfer to your hotel. Overnight stay.

● **Día 9** · Amman - Petra

· Breakfast at the hotel. Take to the road towards Petra. Spend the day visiting the famed Nabatean capital of Petra. During the visit tour the most important and representative monuments sculpted in the rock by this ancient civilization. Admire the Treasury, the famous and most internationally recognised

monument, as seen in one of the Indiana Jones films, the Colored Tombs and the Royal Tombs, and get to know more about life here in ancient times. Petra is one of those places in the world that you must visit at least once in your life. At the end of the visit, in the afternoon, return to the hotel. Overnight stay in Petra.

● **Día 10** · Madaba - Mount Nebo - Allenby Bridge – Tel Aviv

After breakfast , depart to Madaba to visit the ancient Byzantine city and see the ancient Mosaic of the map of the Holy Land and ruins of historic sites. Continue about 10 km to Mount Nebo , where Moses admired the promised land. From that point we will enjoy a magnificent panoramic view of the Jordan Valley, Jerico and the Dead Sea. Continue to the Bridge and return to Tel-Aviv. Overnight in Tel Aviv

● **Día 11** · Tel Aviv - UK

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport for a flight back to the UK. Arrive in the UK and end your trip.
