#### **Ida**

##### ● **Día 1** · UK - Night on board

· Arrival at UK departure airport ready to check-in for overnight flight to Australia. Night on board.

##### ● **Día 2** · On board

· Continue your journey to Australia.

##### ● **Día 3** · Melbourne

· Arrive in Melbourne the garden city of Australia. Arrive and transfer to the hotel. We suggest visiting its lively centre to discover its cafes, bars and boutiques. At dusk, we recommend enjoying a delicious Chinese meal in Little Bourke Street or Italian specialities in a trattoria and listen to live jazz in one of the many jazz bars. Overnight stay.

##### ● **Día 4** · Melbourne

· This morning, enjoy a fascinating guided tour of multicultural Melbourne, an artistic city by definition where museums, galleries and theatres converge to symbolise its rich history. This impressive city attracts culture lovers, sports fans, fashionistas and gastronomic gourmets. Explore at your leisure after the tour. Overnight stay.

##### ● **Día 5** · Melbourne - Great Ocean Road - Melbourne

· Today discover the Great Ocean Road, one of the world's most spectacular and naturally stunning coastal drives. Take a tour, starting in Melbourne and enjoy the stunning scenery along the way. Take in all the famous sights of the Great Ocean Road as you twist and snake along some of the world's most scenic coastlines, from surfer beaches to ancient rainforests. Travel through popular resort towns Anglesea, Lorne, Wye River, Apollo Bay and Port Campbell and discover the iconic Twelve Apostles boardwalk, Loch Ard Gorge and Island Arch. Return to Melbourne for an overnight stay.

##### ● **Día 6** · Melbourne - Adelaide

· Transfer to the airport for a flight to Adelaide, the cosmopolitan coastal capital of Australia, known for its arts scene, sporting events and beautiful beaches. Spend the remainder of the day at your leisure and overnight stay in Adelaide.

##### ● **Día 7** · Adelaide

· Spend the day at your leisure. We suggest visiting the city's Botanic Gardens for a relaxing afternoon admiring the tropical plants, or sports lovers might want to tour the Adelaide Oval. Overnight stay.

##### ● **Día 8** · Adelaide

· Free day to enjoy the city. We recommend visiting the famous Art Gallery of South Australia, which displays a huge collection of indigenous art pieces. Alternatively, why not relax on one of the many beaches that run along the outside of the city. Overnight stay.

##### ● **Día 9** · Adelaide - Kangaroo Island

· Set off by ferry for an exciting full-day tour of Kangaroo Island, an unspoilt island located just off the coast of Adelaide and home to an array of native wildlife. First, stop at Emu Ridge Eucalyptus Distillery and enjoy the fragrant scent of eucalyptus oil and learn about its uses and historical significance. Next, continue to Vivonne Bay and enjoy a delicious two-course lunch. In the afternoon, visit the Seal Bay conservation park, where you walk amongst Australian Sea Lions before an impressive Birds of Prey display showcases an array of Australian bird-life. Lastly, end the day in the Wildlife Park, where you can see kangaroos, penguins and koalas, among other fascinating wildlife native to Australia. Transfer to the hotel for an overnight stay in Kangaroo Island.

##### ● **Día 10** · Kangaroo Island - Adelaide

· Breakfast at the hotel before setting off to visit Clifford's Honey Farm, for an informative look at bee-keeping and a delicious tasting session. Next, travel to Hanson Bay for a two-course lunch and discover the wildlife in the area at the local wildlife sanctuary. End the afternoon on the west of the island where you can enjoy views of Admiral's Arch and the stunning coastline. Take the ferry back to Adelaide for an overnight stay.

##### ● **Día 11** · Adelaide - Ayers Rock

Transfer to the Airport for a flight to Ayers Rock. Arrive, transfer to the hotel and freshen up before you are free to explore this wonderful region, a national park, which aims to keep indigenous culture and traditions alive. Enjoy an unforgettable Sunset Tour of Ayers Rock & Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park. Watch the sunset over Ayers Rock as you sip a glass of sparkling wine and enjoy some light refreshments and experience the beautiful night's sky. An unmissable photo opportunity. Return to the hotel and overnight stay.

#### ● **Día 12** · Ayers Rock

Leave for the Ayers Rock rock formation to enjoy the first rays of sunshine while sipping coffee and enjoying an outback picnic breakfast. Continue with a guided tour of Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park and around the base of the iconic Ayers rock. Later, walk through Mutitjulu Walk, a path through the rock base where you can see Aboriginal rock paintings and learn the history of this mountain. Discover Walpa Gorge, a desert refuge for thriving plant and animal species before returning to the hotel. Rest of the day at your leisure and overnight stay.

#### ● **Día 13** · Ayers Rock - Cairns

Transfer to the airport to board a flight to Cairns, known as the gateway to the Great Barrier Reef. Cairns offers all the facilities of a modern city, first-class restaurants, art galleries, botanical gardens, casinos, a marina and a dock where a large number of yachts and cruises of great renown dock. Explore the city at your leisure. Overnight stay.

#### ● **Día 14** · Cairns - Wooroonooran - Cairns

Embark on a full-day tour to the world's biggest World Heritage Tropical Rainforest in Australia, the Wooroonooran Rainforest just outside of Cairns. The national park is home to the two highest mountains in Queensland and boasts glistening waterfalls and beautifully clear swimming gorges. Explore the rainforest and watch out for the varied wildlife. Enjoy bird watching in the lush surroundings and be amazed as your guide points out crocodiles and other wildlife. Return to Cairns for an overnight stay.

#### ● **Día 15** · Cairns - Great Barrier Reef - Cairns

Today you will embark on a full day Boat Cruise, where you will discover the beauty and diversity of the Great Barrier Reef, close-up! Buffet Lunch included. Soak up the sun and the colourful reef life on this exciting cruise upon the tropical waters of Cairns. Transfer back to the hotel. Overnight stay.

#### ● **Día 16** · Cairns - Sydney

Transfer to the airport for a flight to Sydney. Arrive in Sydney, a dynamic and cosmopolitan city that surprises visitors with its mixture of cultures. Transfer to the hotel. Rest of the day free to get to know the largest and most populated city in Australia and Oceania. Overnight stay.

#### ● **Día 17** · Sydney-Bondi-Sydney

Depart from your hotel for a half day sightseeing tour in Sydney & Bondi. Discover Sydney Opera House and the view from Sydney Harbour Bridge. Admire the vistas from Mrs Macquarie's Point and visit St. Mary's Cathedral. Explore districts such as the historic Rocks and diverse Kings Cross. Stop at the world famous Bondi Beach and enjoy the spectacular scenery and lively atmosphere. Spend the afternoon at your leisure and overnight stay.

#### ● **Día 18** · Sydney

Spend the day at your leisure, sampling the many varied and delicious cuisines of the city or enjoying more sightseeing at the city's many museums and galleries. Overnight stay.

#### ● **Día 19** · Sydney- Grand Blue Mountains - Sydney

Embark on an exciting tour of the Grand Blue Mountains. Explore the World Heritage Blue Mountains where you can expect crisp and refreshing mountain air, beautiful landscapes and waterfalls hidden within the lush rainforest. Spend the day enjoying the surrounding nature and learn about the region from your guide. Return to Sydney for an overnight stay.
