Detalles del viaje: 13 días

Ida

● **Día 1** · UK - Night on board

· Arrival at UK departure airport ready to check in for overnight flight to Santiago.

● **Día 2** · Santiago

· Arrive in Santiago and transfer to the hotel. Spend the rest of the day at your leisure, exploring the beautiful city which is surrounded by Andean mountains and boasts a charming historic centre. We recommend strolling around the Plaza de Armas in the colonial centre of the city and people watching outside one of the many cafes. Overnight stay.

● **Día 3** · Santiago

· Breakfast at the hotel. Enjoy an included city tour of Santiago and Santa Lucia Hill. Pass the Moneda Palace, the seat of the Government, before continuing onto the ambient Plaza de Armas where you can admire the towering spire of the Cathedral. Next, visit the verdant Parque Forest, an impressive city park, to enjoy the gorgeous greenery and sculptures before venturing to the artistic neighbourhood of Bellavista. The highlight of the tour will be to ascend to the summit of Saint Lucia hill to admire panoramic views of the city and the backdrop of the Andes. Overnight at hotel.

● **Día 4** · Santiago - Valparaíso - Viña del Mar - Santiago

· Breakfast at the hotel. Set off for the cities of Valparaíso & Viña del Mar on an included excursion. Valparaíso will charm you with its UNESCO World Heritage historic and its quaint port harbour. Visit the many plazas of the city before touring the impressive National Congress building. Continue along the coast, admiring the landscapes and sea views before arriving in the city of Viña del Mar, which is said to be modelled on the French Riviera. It is a resort town and a popular holiday destination, although it has more to offer than it's holiday atmosphere. It is home to historic hotels, fancy casinos and is nicknamed 'The Garden City'. Visit the city's Museum of Anthropology for a fascinating look at some of South America's most important artefacts and historic relics. Enjoy stretching your legs with a stroll along the promenade before returning to Santiago for an overnight stay.

● **Día 5** · Santiago - San Pedro de Atacama

· Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to airport for flight to Calama. On arrival transfer to San Pedro de Atacama situated in the dusty plateaus of the Andean mountains. Arrive at the hotel and begin exploring this town, set within breath-taking natural scenery. Overnight stay.

● **Día 6** · San Pedro de Atacama

· Breakfast at the hotel. Today, embark on an exciting included tour to the Valle de la Luna (Moon Valley) and the Salares de Atacama. The Valle de la Luna will amaze you with its moon like terrain and unusual rock formations, a huge sand dune and pink-streaked mountains. Next, explore Salares de Atacama, the largest salt-flat in Chile and the perfect spot for impressive photographs. Return to San Pedro for an overnight stay.

● **Día 7** · San Pedro de Atacama

· Breakfast at the hotel. Spend the rest of the day at your leisure and enjoy an overnight stay.

● **Día 8** · San Pedro de Atacama - Punta Arenas - Puerto Natales

· Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport for flight to Punta Arenas. On arrival transfer to hotel, situated in stunning Puerto Natales and then enjoy exploring this formerly modest fishing port. Make sure to see the pretty corrugated tin houses and cozy granny style lodgings as well as enjoying the international restaurants and cafes. Overnight stay.

● **Día 9** · Puerto Natales

· Breakfast at the hotel. Today, enjoy an exciting included trip to Torres del Paine National Park and the Milodon Cave. Be immersed in the fabulous landscape of Patagonia as you explore the national park which is home to soaring mountains and glistening glaciers, as well as rare wildlife including pumas! Stop at Milodon Cave, one of the most important paleontological sites in South America, home to the remains of prehistoric mammals. Continue into the National Park where the highlight of the trip is seeing the three granite peaks that the park owes its name to. The three peaks emerge majestically into horned shapes in the skyline. Torres del Paine National Park is home to unimaginable natural beauty. After a tasty lunch, visit the viewpoint of Lake Nordenskiöld and then Laguna Amarga, before visiting the Paine Waterfall, a beautiful place where you can appreciate the crystal clear waters and the wonders of nature. Enjoy the visit before heading back to Puerto Natales for an overnight stay.

● **Día 10** · Puerto Natales

Breakfast at the hotel. Free day to maybe do some shopping. Puerto Natales is famous for its production of Gore Tex products. Overnight stay.

● **Día 11** · Puerto Natales - Santiago

After breakfast at the hotel transfer to the airport for flight to Santiago. On arrival transfer to hotel. Plenty of free time to explore the city. Overnight stay.

● **Día 12** · Santiago - Night on board

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Santiago airport for flight back to the UK. Night on board

● **Día 13** · UK

Arrival at UK airport and end of your trip.
