Ida

● Día 1 · España - Tashkent

- AM . Arrival Tashkent midnight. Go through customs procedures; meet guide at the exit of the airport. Transfer to hotel. Take rest. Breakfast at hotel. v
- Mustakillik Square – former “Red Squire” the main square of the Tashkent with the monument to victims of the WW II. v Museum of History – newest museum, opened in 2003, this museum is the biggest history museum in the republic, containing departments of Ancient History (with 2 expositions of Buddha), Middle Ages, Islam in Uzbekistan, New History (19-20c) and Modern Uzbekistan. v Amir Temur Square – central park with the statue of Amir Temur v Tashkent Metro stations – construction began in 1972 and five years later the first train rolled. Some people say that Tashkent metro is one of the beautiful metro stations. v Khast Imom Complex including Barak Khan Madrassah, Kaffal Shashi mausoleum, Quran Library & Mosque. v The Roman Catholic Church of Tashkent Dinner at a local restaurant. Acc in the hotel

● Día 2 · Tashkent – Bukhara

- Breakfast at hotel or boxes. Transfer at the railway station and take the train Afrosiab SS of Bukhara: v ARK Fortress (VI – XIX c) – in middle ages it was a whole town with the emirs house, with wives, mosques mint place, government institutes, store rooms, a prison and a square for public executions: v Bolo Khauz Mosque (1712) Mosque Near the Pool. v Chashma Ayub Mausoleum – the original construction dates from the 12 th century rule of Karakhanid Arslan Khan, the earliest surviving dome was raised by Amir Temur in 1380 over the existing tomb chamber. v Samanid's mausoleum (IX – X c) – it was the first building in Central Asia constructed from backed bricks in the shape of a cube covered by a dome with unrepeatable geometrical brickwork design – a masterpiece of world architecture Dinner in the local restaurant Acc in the hotel

● Día 3 · Bukhara

- Breakfast. Full day SS of Bukhara: v Poikalon (XII – XVI c) architectural ensemble in the center of old Bukhara – includes the cathedral mosque “Masjidi Kalon”, “Miri Arab” madrassah and the highest minaret (46 m) at that time in the Orient. v Trading Domes consists of three trading centers: Tok-i-Zargaron (1570) – Jeweler’s Bazaar, Tok-i-Tilpak Furushon – Cap Maker’s Bazaar, Tok-i-Sarrafon – Moneychanger’s Bazaar. v Lyabi – Haus (XVI – XVII c) – a complex with Nodir – Devon Begi madrassah big pool surrounded by trees Dinner with folklore show.

● Día 4 · Bukhara – Gijduvan - Samarkand

- Breakfast Drive to Gijduvan by car/jeep/bus v Visit at the Ceramics factory v Madrasah de Ulugbek Continue driving to Samarkand Arrival to Samarkand. Free time Dinner at the restaurant Acc in the hotel in Samarkand

● Día 5 · Samarkand

- Breakfast.. SS of Samarkand: v Gur Amir mausoleum (XV c) Timurids dynastic burial vault. A unique monument of architecture with blue ribbed tessellated dome v Registan Square (XV–XVIIc) official center of Timur Empire, consist of grandiose Madrassah of Ulugbek, Sher Dor & Tillya Kari. v Bibi Khanum mosque (XIVc) built by Timur to be biggest mosque at time. Architect, craftsmen & painters built in 5 years long. v Siab Bazaar – main bazaar of Samarkand, staying on the crossroad of ancient trading routes. Dinner at National house with Uzbek cuisine. O/n at hotel.

● Día 6 · Samarkand – Tashkent

- Breakfast. SS of Samarkand incl: v Shahi Zinda mausoleum (XIV–XV c) ‘Town of Dead’ a complex of more than 20 unique buildings of different ages. v Visit local bakery v Ulugbek’s Observatory (XV c) 1 st observatory in orient with 30m sextant built by Ulugbek to make exact astronomical catalogue v Afrasiab Museum – each hall of the museum contains exhibits of some certain period of history of Afrasiab. There is also a hall with remarkable ancient wall paintings special lightening. Transfer to train station for train “Afrosiab” to Tashkent at 17:30-19:40. Arrival and have farewell dinner. O/n at hotel.

● Día 7 · Tashkent - España

Transfer to airport for flight to Origen by TK flight. Llegada a la ciudad de origen..
