Ida

● **Día 1** · UK- Lima

Arrival at UK departure airport. Board flight to Lima. Arrive in Lima. Own arrangements for transfer and overnight stay.

● **Día 2** · Lima

Own arrangements to first hotel. Package begins. Overnight stay. *Check-in at 15:00. You can purchase Early Check-In in the next step of the booking process.

● **Día 3** · Lima

Breakfast at the hotel. We suggest two optional excursions. Overnight stay. *Visit the districts of Miraflores and San Isidro. Enjoy the panoramic view of Huaca Huallamarca and visit the Sant Domingo Convent. Walk through Plaza Mayor which is surrounded by Arzobispal palace, the metropolitan municipality and the cathedral. Stop to try a traditional Pisco Sour. Finally, visit the the Larco museum whose artefacts display more than 3000 years of Pre-Columbian history. Overnight stay. Price per person £25*. **Lima city of Flavors: Begin your culinary adventure at a typical Peruvian market. Then visit an exclusive restaurant in Lima where you will learn to prepare pisco sour and ceviche, and enjoy a delicious lunch with Peru's most important dishes. Excursion only available on Monday, Wednesday, Friday or Saturday. Price per person: £67.20.

● **Día 4** · Lima - Puno

Breakfast* at the hotel. Take a flight from Lima's airport to Juliaca. Arrival to Juliaca and transfer to Puno. Overnight stay in Puno.

● **Día 5** · Puno

Breakfast at the hotel. Excursion to Taquile and Uros island. Depart to Taquile island - Taquile has remnants of the past which date back to pre-Inca times. The islanders are famous for their beautiful clothing, their incredible knits, and textile industry. Next, visit the community of Huayllano, on the same island, where the locals show their traditional crafts and agriculture. Lunch. Visit the islands of Uros situated in the middle of the national reserve of Lake Titicaca. Transfer to hotel. Overnight stay.

● **Día 6** · Puno - Cuzco

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Puno station to take a bus to Cuzco. Leave the station and start your journey on the bus to Puno and enjoy the marvelous landscapes of the South Valley of Cuzco. Visit Andahuaylas, the beautiful church of 17 th century, featuring an impressive organ decorated with angels and cherubs. Later on, visit the ruins of Racqui, also known as the Temple of the God Wiracocha and have lunch. Discover La Raya, the highest point on the highway between Cuzco and Puno for amazing views of the landscape. Arrival in Cuzco and transfer to hotel. Overnight stay.

● **Día 7** · Cuzco - Machu Picchu - Aguas Calientes

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the train station of Cuzco. Your adventure starts onboard the Expedition train heading towards Aguas Calientes. Upon arrival, head to Machu Picchu for an unforgettable experience. Once in Machu Picchu, you will be able to cover each corner of this seventh wonder of the world, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Return to the town of Aguas Calientes for lunch. Rest of the day is free. Dinner and overnight stay.* *Please note: for your overnight stay in Aguas Calientes, you will leave your main suitcases and baggage at the hotel in Cuzco and you are permitted to take only a small overnight rucksack or bag for the journey to Machu Picchu on the Expedition train.

● **Día 8** · Aguas Calientes - Cuzco

Breakfast at the hotel. At the indicated time, return to Cuzco. Arrival and transfer to hotel and day free to explore the area.

● **Día 9** · Cuzco

Breakfast at the hotel. We suggest taking the optional excursion for £45*. Overnight stay. *Begin the day at Chinchero, a small picturesque town home to the important archeological Inca site, constructed in the final years of the decade of 1400, a beautiful and traditional church. Visit "Urpi" a famous textile centre, where the town people have conserved the Andean spinning techniques of knitting. Visit Ollantaytambo a fort which also served as a temple. On your way to Ollantaytambo, stop by Racchi viewpoint for a stunning picturesque photographic opportunity. Afterwards, continue towards the town adjacent to Ollantaytambo, "the only alive Inca town" which hasn't been inhabited since the 13th century.

● **Día 10** · Cuzco

Breakfast at the hotel. You are free to spend the day at your leisure and explore the former Capital of the Incas.

● **Día 11** · Cuzco- Buenos Aires

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport for a flight to Buenos Aires. Arrival in Buenos Aires, transfer to the hotel and the rest of the day is free for you to explore this sprawling city, full of colonial architecture and vibrant culture. Overnight in Buenos Aires.

● **Día 12** · Buenos Aires

Breakfast at the hotel. Today, enjoy an included tour of the chic city of Buenos Aires. Visit the most emblematic sites and monuments of the capital, such as the Plaza de Mayo filled with soul and history, the picturesque district of La Boca, the Obelisk representing the symbol of the Argentine capital, or the Casa Rosada where the artist Madonna performed the hit song "Do not cry for me Argentina" in 1996. In the evening, why not indulge in an optional Dinner & Tango Show. Overnight stay. * Optional Dinner & Tango Show: An immersive evening of Argentinian food and arts at the Dinner and Tango Show. £80 per person.

● **Día 13** · Buenos Aires

Breakfast at the hotel. Continue enjoying the city at your leisure. We recommend visiting the magnificent parks of the city such as the Ecological Reserve, located behind the Puente de la Mujer in the Puerto Madero neighbourhood, is an oasis of peace and tranquillity in the open air. Overnight stay.

● **Día 14** · Buenos Aires- Iguazu Falls

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport for flight to Iguazu, home of the mighty Iguazu Falls! Take the day at your leisure and if the arrival time allows, we suggest enjoying a bike ride through the jungle or rest in this beautiful natural setting. Overnight in hotel.

● **Día 15** · Iguazu Falls

Breakfast at the hotel. Visit the Argentinian side of Iguazu Falls by taking the train to the 'Devil's Throat' where a lookout area grants the opportunity to watch the water rush from the river and down an 80 metre (262 feet) high sheer drop. Walk across bridges and enjoy the panoramic views on offer. Hear the roar of water whilst contemplating spectacular views of rainbows, birds, leafy green exotic plants and trees. In the evening, visit a local market where you have the opportunity to try traditional food and local wine.* Return to the hotel for an overnight stay. *Optional Iguazu Great Adventure: Enter the jungle by the Yacaratí trail in trucks specially designed for this environment. This 5 kms long stretch ends at Puerto Macuco. At its dock, board a boat that sails in the Lower Iguazu River for as long as 6 kms, heading towards the waterfalls area, enjoying plentiful rapids. Upon reaching the Tres Mosqueteros Fall, see the falls of both the Argentinian and Brazilian sides crowned by the view of the Garganta del Diablo (Devil's Throat). Afterwards, the most exciting point comes when facing the incomparable San Martín waterfall, the second in dimension and the hugest any boat may face. Price: £65 per person

● **Día 16** · Iguazu Falls

Breakfast at hotel. Visit the Brazilian side of the Iguazu Falls, one of the world's Seven Natural Wonders. Walk on trails and enjoy a spectacular panoramic view of one of the biggest waterfall systems in the world. Overnight stay.

● **Día 17** · Iguazu Falls- Río de Janeiro

Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to the airport for a flight to Rio de Janeiro. Transfer to your hotel and the rest of the day free. We recommend a stroll along Rio's famous beaches, Copacabana and Ipanema. Overnight in Rio de Janeiro.

● **Día 18** · Río de Janeiro

Breakfast at hotel. Spend the day taking an included city tour of wonderful Rio and Corcovado Mountain, which includes a trip up to the famous Christ the Redeemer statue. Visit the famous Corcovado mountain, one of the Seven Wonders of the Modern World and where you can watch the city from afar and admire the view of Lagoa Rodrigo de Freitas. Christ Redeemer is more than 700m in height and dominates the city's skyline. Admire the iconic Christ the Redeemer; an immense rock statue built by the sculptor Francés Paul Landowski which celebrates the visit of Carioca. Descend from the hills to enjoy a visit to Maracanã and a visit to the Sambódromo, where the Rio Carnival takes place yearly. Soak up the vibrant atmosphere of this lively city. Overnight in Rio de Janeiro.

● **Día 19** · Río de Janeiro

Breakfast at the hotel. You are free to spend the day at your leisure. Overnight stay. *Optional: Tour of downtown Rio and Sugar Loaf Mountain. Price: £56.25 per person.

● **Día 20** · Río de Janeiro- Night on board

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport for a flight back to the UK. Night on board.

● **Día 21** · UK

Arrive in the UK and end your trip.
